<b>Course description</b>										
Slight drop out of the start is followed by a roller and a small kicker (Reaction). Then a small step up leads to a sharp step down and a medium kicker. After a slight turn to the right a big double is followed by a banked turn to the right and a negative turn to the right. Then a step down (INT 1) leads to a turn to the left and a medium kicker. The next slight turn to the left leads to a big double and a step up, followed by a slight turn to the right and a step down. After a compression a small kicker is followed by a turn to the left with a pro jump and a medium corner jump to the right. Then a turn to the right is followed by a slightly banked turn to the left, then a double roller and a step up (INT 2 in take off) with double landing. The next two rollers lead to a turn to the right and a big step down (ICR 4512 line in the take off) and long inrun to the finish. The exit is on the right end of the finish.
