GENERAL RULES

The competition is organized according to the ICR and FIS rules.

ELIGIBILITY

All entrants must hold active FIS licenses and be entered on official FIS entry forms. FIS races all ages welcome. NJC races athletes must be born between 2000-2004.



LIFT TICKETS

Competitor passes are available from Sunday October 01 after bib collection, children \$40 per day, adults (competitors 18yrs old) \$70 per day.

INFO & ENTRY

All entries must be handled through the Snow Sports New Zealand website and all entries must be members of Snow Sports New Zealand (international and national).

Memberships cost \$20 NZD for U16 and \$60 NZD for 16 and over.

New Zealand athletes who need a FIS license can purchase them by creating a membership on Snow Sports NZ and selecting the FIS option for \$200 NZD.

New Zealand athletes with a current SSNZ membership can update their membership to FIS by paying the difference in membership costs. Please contact info@snowsports.co.nz

Entry fee is \$45 NZD per event.

International athletes must also get their National Federation to send in the official FIS entry form. FIS licenses for international competitors must also be handled by their respective National Federations.
