Rules:

The event is sanctioned by the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association and the FIS and organized by Alberta Freestyle Skiing Association and hosted by WinSport's Canada Olympic Park.

The Organizing Committee will host the event in accordance with the International Freestyle Ski Competition Rules of the FIS and operated in accordance with the NorAm Standard Operating Procedures.

All athletes entered in a NorAm Cup competition must hold a valid FIS License issued under the authority of their national ski association and conform to the rules in the FIS ICR Sections 203 and 204.

The competition is comprised of Moguls and Dual Moguls events.

Proof of Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers. Coaches must have Aerial Passports accessible to the Event Jury.

Competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program:

- **Thursday, February 22, 2018 – Training**
- **Friday, February 23, 2018 – Training**
- **Saturday, February 24, 2018– Single Moguls**
- **Sunday February 25, 2018 – Dual Moguls**

Race Office:

Participants must check in and pick up competition bibs to confirm participation. The Race office is in the Olympic Theatre in the Frank King Day Lodge

Unused Quota

It is permitted (Moguls/Aerials) to fill 75% of unused quota spots for one gender with athletes from the other gender within rule 5.0 per NSA.

Format

Single Mogul Format:

Single run Qualification; followed by single run Final with the top 16 females and 16 males; followed by single run Super Final featuring the top 6 females and 6 males.

Qualification one run

Final top 16 females & top 16 males

Super Final top 6 females & top 6 males

Dual Mogul Format:

Dual Moguls will seed off latest available FIS points ranking, athletes will hold that seeding for both events.

Entry and Registration Information:

Entries must be received no later than January 30, 2018

Lift tickets will be offered to team members as follows and can be purchased at the Guest Services Window when you present your bib:

Competitors: A lift ticket will be available for **CA\$ 25+tax/day**

Coaches: A complimentary lift ticket will be available for team coaches at the Race Office

Refunds:

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, refunds will not be issued. In the case of an injury the coach or parent must notify the registration desk, to inform that an athlete is injured and unable to ski before the team captains meeting the day before the comp. Athletes are entitled to partial refunds of up to 50% per event. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered only at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. If an event is cancelled due to weather or exceptional circumstances no refunds will be provided. The organizing committee has already incurred all costs for the event. Bibs

A deposit in cash of CA\$ 20.00 is required per competitor which will be refunded upon return of the bib. We cannot guarantee that bib deposit made in US currency will be remitted in the same.
