Course description						
<p>Out of the start a Free Drop leads to a WuTang, short dish and a Take Off with two optional landings. Then a steep pitch is leading to a Big Kicker and a banked turn to the right. The next Big Double Roller is followed by a Dragons Pack (five rollers) and a slight flat turn to the left.</p> <p>Then a Big Kicker (INT 1 in take off) with long landing leads to a slight turn to the right, followed by a compression and a Step Up Table. Slight drop from the Table then is followed by Negative Turn to the right, a bowled turn to the left and a Big Step Down with medium landing. The next flat turn to the right leads to a slightly further right turning Step Up - Step Down Combo with a medium landing. The next Medium Double Roller is followed by a banked turn to the left and a short take off (INT 2) with two landings and an other Medium Double Roller into a banked turn to the right.</p> <p>The Final Straight Section starts with a Medium Step Up Butter with Medium Kicker Exit with double landing. A compression then leads to a Medium Step Up with three optional landings. The next Big Kicker is followed by a Final Big Jump (ICR4512.1 line in take off) with long landing and inrun to the finish.</p>
