- The French Freestyle Association and the Savoie Ski Committee are organizing an international Big Air FIS Cup competition, part of the 2017/2018 FIS Ski Freestyle FIS Cup Circuit.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for Freestyle skiing.

4. REGISTRATION AND MEANS OF PAYMENT

Team registration and payment will take place on

- Sunday 25th February 2018 from 8.15 to 9.30

All fees and deposits must be paid in cash in euros.

No CB, checks or travellers will be accepted.

Entry (included skipass) :

€ 20 per athlete per FIS race

Coaches :

according the FIS rules

1-3 competitors = 1 coach free

4-8 competitors = 2 coaches free

9 or more competitors = 3 coaches free

BEWARE: 20 € on cash as a deposit for each bib

5. ACCOMMODATIONS

Teams are free to book the accommodation of their choice.

6. BIBS AND HELMETS

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets during official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A penalty will be given to any competitors who do not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 10 € per bib. The deposit will be refunded at the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

7. LIABILITY

All competitors, officials and other members of their National Association who attend or participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee : Saint Francois Longchamp, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by competitors, officials or any other persons in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all time.

8. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must be individually medically insured. The Organizing Committee : Saint Francois Longchamp ski resort, the FIS and the French Ski Association will not be held responsible for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

9. ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical staff from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the Saint Francois Longchamp Medical Centre or local hospital.
