Course description

A short flat after the start is followed by two small dishes and a short step up and a medium steep step down. Then four rollers lead into an other steep step down and slight turn to the right. The next medium step down leads into a compression and a medium sharp kicker. The next slightly banked turn to the left is followed by four rollers and a medium negative turn to the right. Then a double roller (INT 1 in first roller) is followed by two single rollers and a banked turn to the left with two rollers which are higher on the inside. The next medium step up leads into a bowled turn to the right with a medium step down out of the bowl. Single roller is then followed by a negative turn to the left and a step up kicker (INT 2 in take off). The next roller section with five rollers is then followed by negative turn to the right, a medium step to a butter and a medium step down. Two big kickers lead then to the finish (ICR4512 line in take off of last kicker). The exit is on riders right end of the finish area.
