ENTRY

Entries to FIS Ski Jumping World Cup in Lahti must be done according to FIS Rules via FIS Online Entry System. Deadline for preliminary entries to Lahti by 19 January 2018. Final numbers, accommodation and transportation info is needed by 20 February 2018. Please enter your entries on time. For late entries we may not be able to guarantee all services such as accommodation, transportation or waxing cabins.

RESTRICTIONS AND LIABILITY

FIS Rules will apply. The number of participants must comply with the World Cup rules and regulations. Financial conditions are according to the FIS Rules and regulations. All competitors are to be insured by their own National Ski Association and must have signed the Athletes Declaration. The OC in Lahti has coverage for their own third party liability only.

PAYMENTS

Accommodation costs: Persons from the pay lists will be paid by the OC directly. Other accommodation costs to be paid at accommodation office (main Grandstand Building, field level). Over quota costs will be reduced from the Travel Money.

Reimbursements of expenses / Prize money: Please note that prize money, travel and pocket money is paid only electronically. For electronic payments IBAN (International Bank Account Number) and BIC (Bank Identifier Code) for each transaction. If needed, please provide the information in advance to our financial office at anne.lahdelma@hiihtoliitto.fi According to the FIS rules of the tax-at source act, the tax-at-source rate for sports performances is 15 % for foreign athletes and for USA 0%. The prize-money is paid electronically by latest one week after the last competition.

Financial office is open from Friday 2.3. to Sunday 4.3. at 10:00 - 17:00 (main Grandstand Building, field level). For other times, please refer to competition office (Grandstand building of XC Stadium, ground floor) or Ski Jumping info center (at ski jumping service area).

TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETINGS

Team Captains' Meetings are arranged in auditorium of Ski Museum Building. Team Captains' Meeting is scheduled for Friday 2 March at 15:30.

ACCREDITATION

Team accreditations (and other permission cards) can be picked up at accreditation office that is located in Lahti Exhibition Centre, Lahti Hall, ground floor. Accreditation office is open as follows: Wed 28/2 - Fri 2/3 from 9:00 to 19:00, Sat 3/3 from 8:00 to 18:00 and Sun 4/3 from 8:00 to 14:00

ACCOMMODATION

Booking must be done according to FIS Rules via FIS online system by requesting the number of rooms, SGL / DBL with full-board, and dates of arrival and departure. The OC offers accommodation in Cumulus Lahti (full board) in Lahti City centre according to FIS Rules. For competitors and officials not included in the quota the price is 125 CH per person per night (full board).

Deadline for hotel reservations is 19 January 2018. Due to limited capacity of accommodation for extra persons or for extra single rooms outside quota can not be guaranteed.

TRANSPORTATION
