Renowned for having the best terrain parks east of the Rocky Mountains, Mount St-Louis Moonstone is proud to host Canada Snowboard Nationals in the Outback Super Park this coming March for both Halfpipe and Slopestyle Athletes.

MSLM's Outback Super Park is award winning year after year with accolades from Snowboard Canada Magazine, Transworld Snowboarding and others; the Outback has serious cred. It may be small vertical but the Outback Super Park is mighty. Serviced by a Quad chair, The Outback Super Park's Slopestyle Riders got serious runs last season with varying sizes both medium and large, two(2) jumps lines each containing four (4) jumps including, a gnarly 57' booter onto our BagJump. Grinding rails in the Outback Super Park wicked styles was steezy last season boasting, 35 rail/box features including the longest rail in North America at 140', a 3 rail staircase, and a wicked range of cannons, goal post and shot gun rails. The Outback Super Pipe is sleek and fast with 18' walls to ride and throw down tricks. Eligibility - NorAm Competitions

Competitors must be 13 years of age as at December 31, 2017 In order to receive FIS points, competitors must hold a valid FIS License prior to creation of the TC Meeting scheduled before the Event.

International Athletes Notice

REFUND POLICY

Any refund of Event Registration Fee requires the approval Snowboard Ontario Executive Director.

Request for refund must be submitted by email to: <u>JanetRichter@ontariosnowboarders.ca</u>

The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in event (must be confirmed with doctor's note)
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval of Snowboard Ontario Executive Director

Refunds for cash or cheque transactions must be refunded by cheque. Credit card refunds must be processed via card transaction credit.

Membership, SAIP Insurance and FIS license fees are not refundable. Lift Tickets are not refundable.

SANCTION

Snowboard Ontario, Canada Snowboard, the Federation Internationale de Ski (FIS) and the World Snowboard Federation sanction AIR NATION Mount St Louis Moonstone as a FIS North American Cup and WSF National event.

RULES & REGULATIONS
