## ATHLETE REGISTRATION

## **Registration Deadline**

Online registration is recommended and will close at 9PM on February 12, 2018

Onsite registration is limited to space availability and will close at 3PM on February 13, 2018. Onsite registration will be provided at the event office and in cash only.

#### **International Athletes Notice**

To confirm your registration, the Event Organizers MUST receive a written confirmation from your National Snowboard Association confirming that you are in good standing, prior to your arrival at the event. The confirmation letter can be submitted by email to: evenements@quebecsnowboard.ca

#### Eligibility

Competitors must meet the following age limit in order to compete (FIS Rule 2011.3) SS 13 years of age as at December 31, 2017

In order to be listed on the FIS Ranking, competitors must hold a valid FIS License. Canadian athletes can purchase Provincial/Territorial Advanced Membership, SAIP Insurance and FIS license online under Member Services <u>HERE</u>

- 1 day (online registration): 115\$
- 1 day (onsite registration): 140\$
- 2 days (online registration): 230\$
- 2 days (onsite registration): 280\$

## LIFT TICKETS

Athletes : Discounted lift ticket for training and competition will be offered. Vouchers will be provided at sign in and will be purchased at guest services.

Adult : 34,93\$/day Young adult (13-17 years old) : 27,83\$ Kids (6-12 years old) : 21,91\$

Coaches : Free lift ticket will be available at race office (only coaches who registered online will get free lift ticket)

## **CANADIAN COACHES REGISTRATION**

## **REFUND POLICY**

Request for refund must be submitted by email to: <u>evenements@quebecsnowboard.ca</u> The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in event (must be confirmed with doctor's note)
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval of QC Snowboard Associations Executive Director

Refunds for cash or cheque transactions must be refunded by cheque. Credit card refunds must be processed via card transaction credit. Membership, SAIP Insurance and FIS license fees are not refundable. Lift Tickets are not refundable.

## SANCTION

QC Snowboard Association, Canada Snowboard, the Federation Internationale de Ski (FIS) and the World Snowboard Federation sanction Air Nation Mont-Tremblant as a FIS /TTR National event.

## **RULES AND REGULATION**
