



Event Information

Overview:

The Hole Shot Cross Tour is a competition designed to bridge the gap between grassroots and world cup level for Snowboardcross and ski cross. The event also brings together athletes across the country to identify the top juniors in the country. Athletes 15 (SBX) 16 (SX) and older compete together in an open-class style event. The top juniors will be named to U.S. Snowboarding's and Ski Cross Project Gold, a group of the top development athletes in the country who will train together in the summer and are invited to other select projects. Athletes must have a current National USSA license and FIS license prior to registering for a Hole Shot or Revolution Tour contest. USSA or FIS memberships may not be purchased onsite; memberships must be purchased at least two weeks prior to the event. There will be no onsite registration at the event.

Revolution Tour Overview:

The U.S. Revolution Tour is designed to serve as stepping-stone for athletes making the transition from competing at the grassroots level to the elite level. Athletes ages 15 (SBX & SX) and older compete together in an open-class event. Athletes must have a USSA National Competitor membership and a FIS License to compete. Foreign athletes are only required to hold a FIS membership.

USSA memberships may not be purchased onsite; memberships must be purchased at least two weeks prior to the event. There will be no onsite registration at the event.
