## **6. Bibs and Helmets**

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 10 € per bib. Amount will be refunded by the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

## **7. Liability**

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, la Clusaz, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible to any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all time.

## **8. Accident Insurance**

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, la Clusaz, the FIS and the French Ski Association declines any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

## **9. Accident Protocol**

In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical staff from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decisions or evacuation to local hospital.
