Rules:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) The German Ski Association (DSV) and the organizing committee are organizing a Freestyle Europa Cup Skicross competition for the 2019 FIS Freestyle Europa Cup</li> <li>2) The dates of the Competitions have been published in the International Calendar of the FIS.</li> <li>3) The Competitions will be held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing.</li> <li>4) The Freestyle Europa Cup competition is an event of Ski Cross for ladies and men</li> <li>5) The organizing committee reserves the right to change the schedule or the place of the events from those stated in the program, subject to the snow conditions or the decision of the competition jury.</li> <li>6) According to the ICR Rule 4505.2.1 the format of "No Qualification and Final Format" may be run if there are no more than 64 men and 32 ladies entered for either FIS and EC competition till the first TCM. It is at the discretion of the Jury to adapt the format within the ICR.</li> <li>7) Entries will only be accepted according to the FIS EC Quota regulation</li> </ol>	
Entries:	Entries will only be accepted from National Ski Associations with the official FIS Entry Form, within the FIS EC quota and must be submitted to the organizing committee by e-mail no later than Fri., February 03 <sup>th</sup> 2019.

Method of Payments:	Entry fee shall be paid to the organizing committee in cash in Swiss Franks or Euro during the Team Captain Meeting. Accommodation fee shall be paid directly to the hotel/pension where the team is lodged.
Bibs:	All competitors must wear their bibs during all official trainings, competitions and award winning ceremonies. Each team leader will be asked for <b>50,- € deposit per nation</b> upon registration. Bibs will be taken back after the qualification (for distribution finals) and after the finals.

Price Giving	Award winning ceremonies will be held asap after the finals.

All athletes must have previously signed the "FIS Athletes Declaration" form in order to be registered.
