Registration

By nation (Mandatory for FIS and EC Points)

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the final team entries with a FIS Entry Form to <u>fis@snowpr.pl</u> no later than 3 days prior to the first day of official training. **Entry deadline: February 11th, 2019.** Please mark your Discipline (Freeski or Snowboard)

Online (For OPEN competition)

Open riders may register with the online inscription (deadline 11th of February) www.wsfest.pl/register

All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the Registration for check-in before proceeding to the competition venue. All fees will be collected upon check-in in CASH (CHF / PLN / EUR). Lift tickets are included in the Entry Fee and Training Fee.

The first team captains meeting will be held at the Race Office on Thursday (Feb. 14th) right after training session at 2.00pm CET.

Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during all scheduled official trainings and competitions.

All competitors must have their own medical insurance. The Organising Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers, the FIS and Polish Ski Federation decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.
