Eligibility - NorAm Competitions

Competitors must also hold a valid <u>FIS License</u> in order to be listed on the FIS ranking. Canadian athletes can purchase FIS license, <u>SAIP insurance</u> and <u>Provincial or Territorial</u> <u>Snowboard Association Membership</u> before registering through your Provincial or Territorial Association.
