Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Ski and Snowboard Associations following FIS World Cup quotas and rules. Please submit the provisional entry with anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) by January 28th, 2019. The final entry with number of your competition team and names of participants (including competitors and official) must be submitted to the organizers no later than February 27th, 2019.

Onsite registration / Accreditation

Registration and accreditation will be held after the first TC Meeting at the accreditation office Stradun 322, the office is signed, in Scuol. Please see schedule for registration times. All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the registration area for check-in before proceeding to the competition venues. All fees will be collected upon check-in.

Athlete Participation Fee: CHF 30.00 per competitor only cash and credit card can be accepted at accreditation office.

Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during competition and at the awards ceremony.
