Air Nation Mount St Louis Moonstone is the 3rd stop of the 2019 Air Nation Freestyle Tour.

Air Nation Mount St Louis Moonstone brings together the best freestyle snowboarding athletes in North American to compete in 1 Slopestyle and 1 Big Air event over two days.

THE RESORT

The Ontario stop of AIR NATION FREESTYLE TOUR will be held in the heart of Simcoe Country. Mount St-Louis Moonstone.

Renowned for having the best terrain parks east of the Rocky Mountains, Mount St-Louis Moonstone is proud to host Canada Snowboard Nationals in the Outback Super Park this coming March for both Halfpipe and Slopestyle Athletes.

MSLM's Outback Super Park is award winning year after year with accolades from Snowboard Canada Magazine, Transworld Snowboarding and others; the Outback has serious cred. It may be small vertical but the Outback Super Park is mighty. Serviced by a Quad chair, The Outback Super Park's Slopestyle Riders got serious runs last season with varying sizes both medium and large, two(2) jumps lines each containing four (4) jumps including, a gnarly 57' booter onto our BagJump. Grinding rails in the Outback Super Park wicked styles was steezy last season boasting, 35 rail/box features including the longest rail in North America at 140', a 3 rail staircase, and a wicked range of cannons, goal post and shot gun rails. The Outback Super Pipe is sleek and fast with 18' walls to ride and throw down



tricks. MSLM is stocked to host Canada's best snowboarder athletes from across the country battling it out in our Outback Super Park this March!

CANADIAN COACHES REGISTRATION

All Canadian coaches at events must register and meet the <u>Canadian Minimum Coach</u> <u>Certification Standards</u>. Please review and understand the Minimum Standards.

CANADIAN COACHES registration will be available December 1st

REFUND POLICY

Any refund of Event Registration Fee requires the approval the Ontario Snowboard Executive Director.

The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in event (must be confirmed with doctor's note)
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval

Refunds for cash or cheque transactions must be refunded by cheque. Credit card refunds must be processed via card transaction credit.

Membership, SAIP Insurance and FIS license fees are not refundable. Lift Tickets are not refundable.
