# Accommodation (World Cup Rules Art. 13)

- Booking according the FIS Rules via FIS Online registration system
- The OC offers following hotel accommodation (full board included):
  - Coast Hotel (primary hotel downtown):
    - \$153.00 per person in double room, \$206.00 single
  - Chateau Canmore (downto
    - \$139.00 per person in double room, \$199.00 single
- At Basecamp Resorts, the OC offers apartment style accommodation suitab for self catered situations. Meals (full board or half board) available at Coast hotel - 5 minutes aways
  - 3 bedroom bunk apartment \$80.34 per person
  - 2 bedroom apartment \$97.56 per person
  - 1 bedroom apartment \$149.21 per person
  - 1 bedroom studio \$126.25 per person
- At Basecamp Lodge, the OC offers the following hotel-style accommodation with meals (full board or half board) available at the Coast Hotel (5 minutes away).
  - King size bedroom (single occupancy): \$103.30 per pers
  - Double Queen size bedroom (double occ): \$63.13 per person
- Additional information about the accommodation will be given to the teams after receiving preliminary entry and accommodation request
- Price for additional accommodation outside of the guota:
  - OC will work with other accommodation provides to find accommodation as required for non-quota persons.
- OC retains the right to make changes.

## **Transport (World Cup Rules Art. 11)**

- Official airport : Calgary International Airport (1.5 hour drive to Canmore
- The organizing committee will arrange transportation between the airport and the hotels. 1 transport (from and to the airport) free of charge. Price for additional transport:
  - \$75.60 for one-way trip to or from the airport
- Information about the Shuttle service
  - Shuttle buses will run from official hotels to race venue.

# Reimbursement (World Cup Rules Art. 10 and 13)

- Accommodation costs: Teams will pay directly to their hotels for all team athletes (incl Red Group), including over-quota costs
- Travel and Living Reimbursement: OC will verify athletes (Red Group, etc eligible for subsidy directly with Team Captains prior to departure from Canmore, and will reimburse the respective NSO by wire transfer within 3 days of event completio



 Wire transfer data from each team NSO must be confirmed at the financial office.

## Prize money payment (Word Cup Rules Art. 8)
