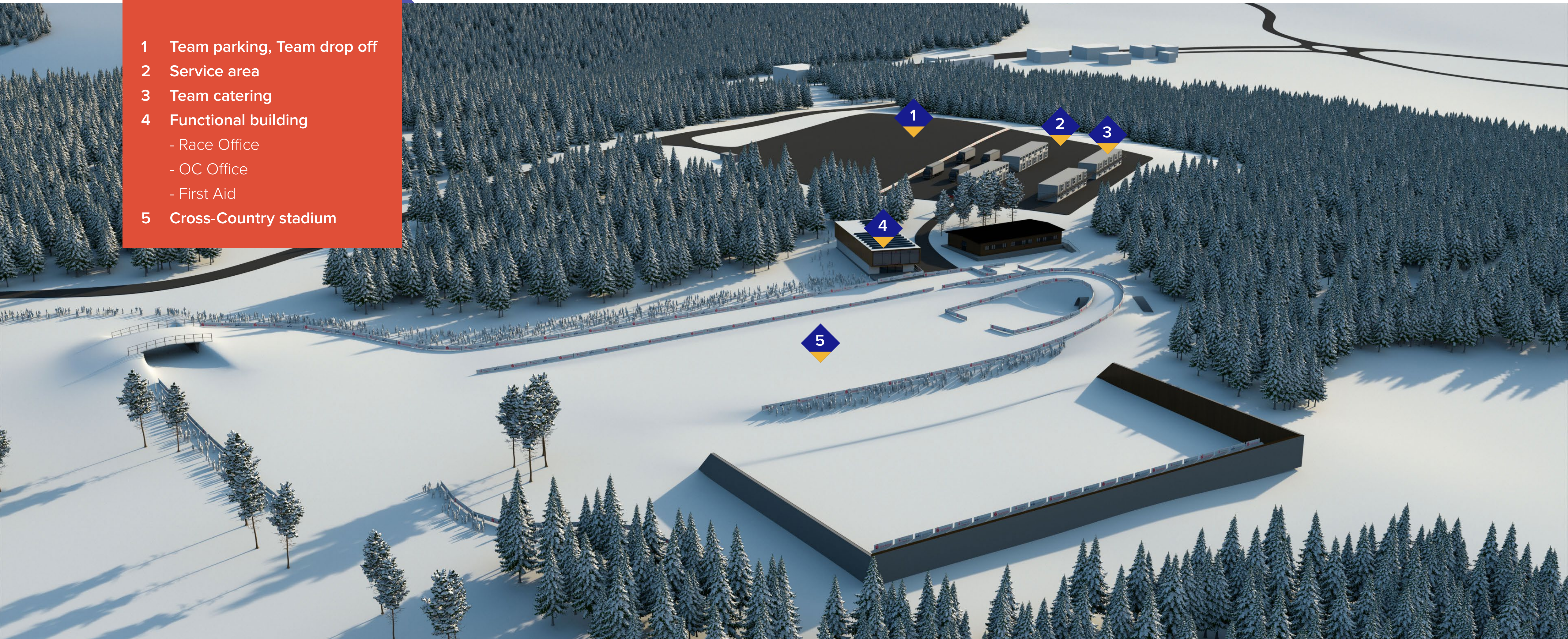

FIS rules will apply (International Ski Competition Rules, Rules for the FIS Nordic Junior World Ski Championships and FIS U23 World Ski Championships Cross-Country).

Right to participate/Entries

All National Ski Associations affiliated with FIS have the right to participate. To be eligible for participation in FIS Nordic Junior World Ski Championships and FIS U23 World Ski Championships Cross-Country, the skiers:

- Must be a citizen of the country entering him or her (article 203.5 ICR)
- have a valid FIS Code
- fulfill any eligibility and qualification criteria laid down in this rules

Age Limits

The FIS competition year is 1st July – 30th June of the following year.

In order to compete in international competitions a competitor must have reached his 16th birthday before the end of the calendar year (1st January – 31st December) in question.

Quota System for Ski Jumping competitors Men

Athletes Quota: 80 (maximum quota)

NSA Quota: up to 5 per NSA (as a maximum)

4 allowed to start per event

Qualification System

Basic Quota: Each participating NSA is allowed to enter up to two athletes in Ski Jumping men.

Host Nation: The host nation is expected to enter competitors up to the maximum NSA quota of 5.

Allocation of Quotas: The allocation of additional quotas per NSA is based on the COC Ranking List (CRL) composed of the results of the past and current seasons. The allocation will be made by assigning one quota place per competitor from the top of the standings downwards. Once a NSA has achieved the maximum number of 5 quota places, the next eligible NSA on the CRL will be allocated a place until the total of 80 competitors is reached (including host nation). If the number of 80 cannot be reached with the CRL, the FIS CUP standings composed of the results of the last and current season will be taken into consideration.

Process and Timeline: The final quotas based on entries (see art. 10.3) and using the CRL resp. FIS Cup standings will be calculated and announced 2 weeks prior to the JWSC.

Deadline for registration

FIS online registration system

Entries (provisional team selection, final team entry) must be made by NSAs in the FIS online registration system. Entries made by email, fax or paper will not be accepted.

Preliminary entry

The preliminary **deadline for entries is December 31st, 2019** per FIS Rule 12.2. Each National Ski Association must send to the Organizing Committee the preliminary entry with the number of competitors, trainers and service staff according to FIS rule 7.1/7.2.

Each NSA must make the preliminary entry with the maximum number of competitors, officials and service staff according to the number of competitors and officials.

Important: Preliminary entries are mandatory for all.

Late entries

After the deadline, the FIS online registration system will remain open. However, the LOC is not obliged to arrange accommodation for the NSA which makes late entries.

Entry by name

All participating NSAs must send their entries by name through the online registration system. The system will be opened for entry by name as soon as the preliminary entry has been done. Entries by name will be used by the LOC to prepare accreditations and to prepare the final entry list. Change of names will still be possible until the day before the first Team Captains meeting (23:59 CET). After the deadline the system will be closed and any changes of the names are only possible after the approval from the respective Jury.

Final entries

The deadline for the final entry for each competition is 2 hours before the respective Team Captains Meeting. The final entry must be done in the Race Office. Only competitors from the final entry by name (FIS

rule 12.3) can be chosen. If a competitor is entered for the Junior World Ski Championships, he/she cannot compete in the U23 World Ski Championships.

Replacement of Competitors after the first TCM

In case of “force majeure” the Jury may permit a substitute to be entered in place of another athlete after the first team captains’ meeting.

Insurance

All athletes and team officials have to be insured by their own NSA. All participants have to be covered by an adequate insurance policy for medical costs, accidents, injury, illness and civil liability.

Anti-Doping

Anti-doping-controls will be done by the NADA and the FIS. The Anti-doping-controls of the NADA will take place in the Olympic Training Centre (Dr.-Jaeger-Str. 2). There will be special shuttles available for this ride. The athletes need to have their ID with them.

The FIS online system is simultaneously the application for accreditation for the FIS Junior World Championships and U23 World Ski Championships Cross-Country.

The Race Office will open two hours before all training or competition sessions and will close one hour after all training or competitions have concluded.

■ Wax Cabins

Waxing cabins are only at the venues. Waxing cabins will be provided according to FIS rule 17.1. Requests for additional wax cabins must be submitted by October 15, 2019 via FIS online tool. Additional wax cabins may be granted depending on availability. The wax-cabins in the Sparkassen-Ski-stadium can be used from 25th of February 2020 on. Teams will receive the keys on pledge and after the conditions of use have been signed in the LOC office.

Ski companies may request one cabin for free. Additional waxing cabins are available for CHF 900 for the dura-

tion of the Event. The company has to order the cabins before 15th of October through SRS (FIS Rule 17.2).

Waxing Trucks

The teams arriving with a waxing truck will not receive any wax cabin. The teams have to confirm to the OC through the online system (in the preliminary entries form) latest 6 weeks before the first competition.

Teams are asked to send their requests for waxing trucks (parking size, power supply, etc.) by October 15, 2019.

■ After October 15th 2019 the LOC can not guarantee for a space for waxing trucks.

Radio Equipment/Frequencies

The import, export and the operation of radio equipment in Germany is regulated by national law. Permits for the use of radio transmission equipment must be requested according to national specifications.

The radio frequencies need to be authorized by the regulatory authority. Unauthorized use is liable to prosecution. Fines of up to EUR 500.000 may be imposed. The authorization fees can be found in the enclosed information form of the regulatory authority.

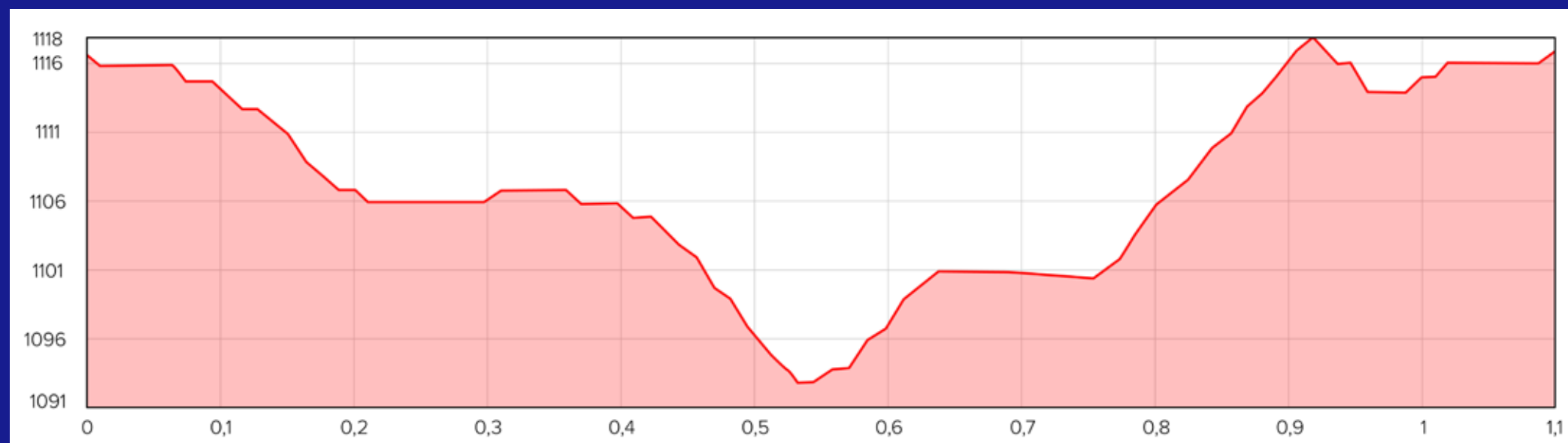

attitude of the routes: 1060 m up to 1145 m N.N.

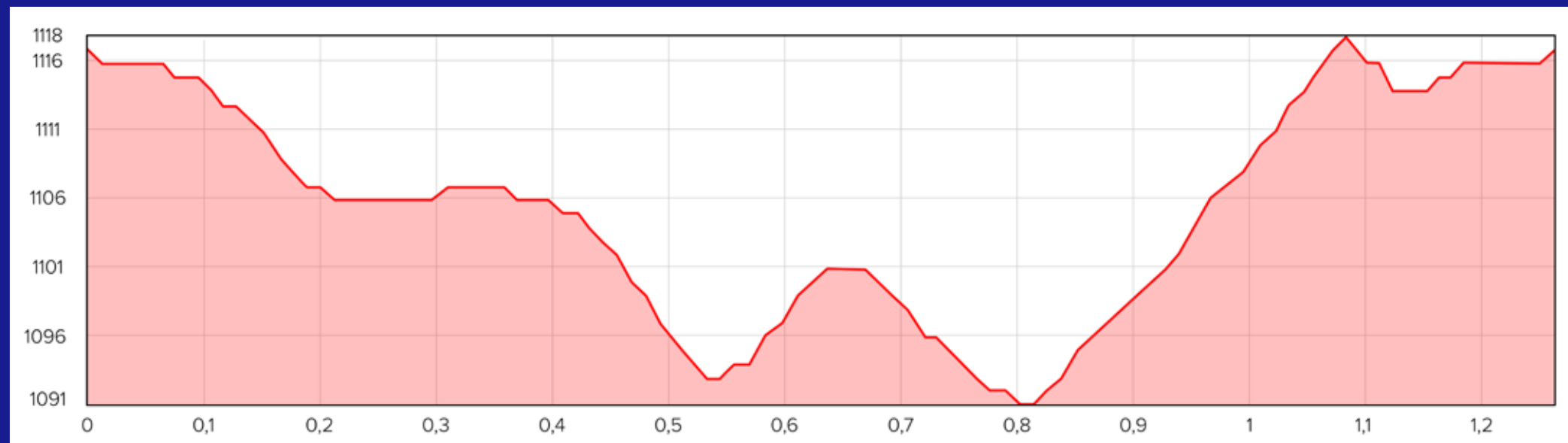
The Sparkasse ski stadium has two route areas in west and north. The routes in the north area have been built especially for the JWSC and replace the previous route network.



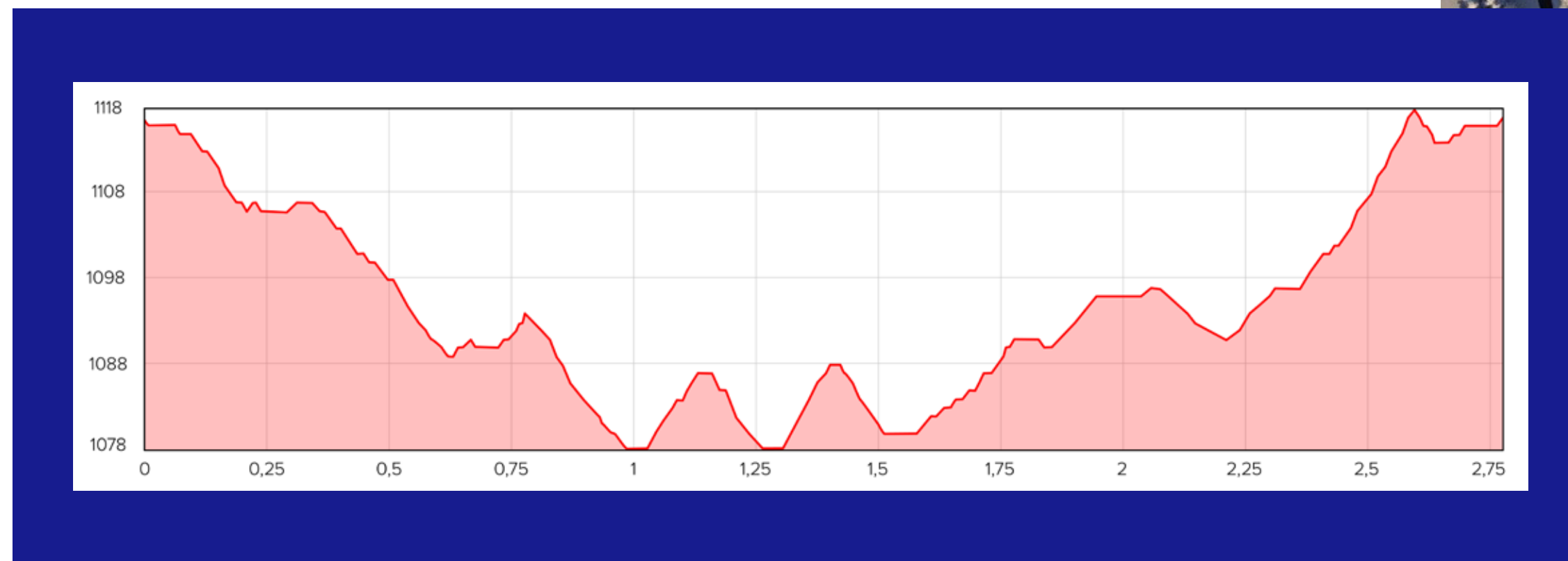
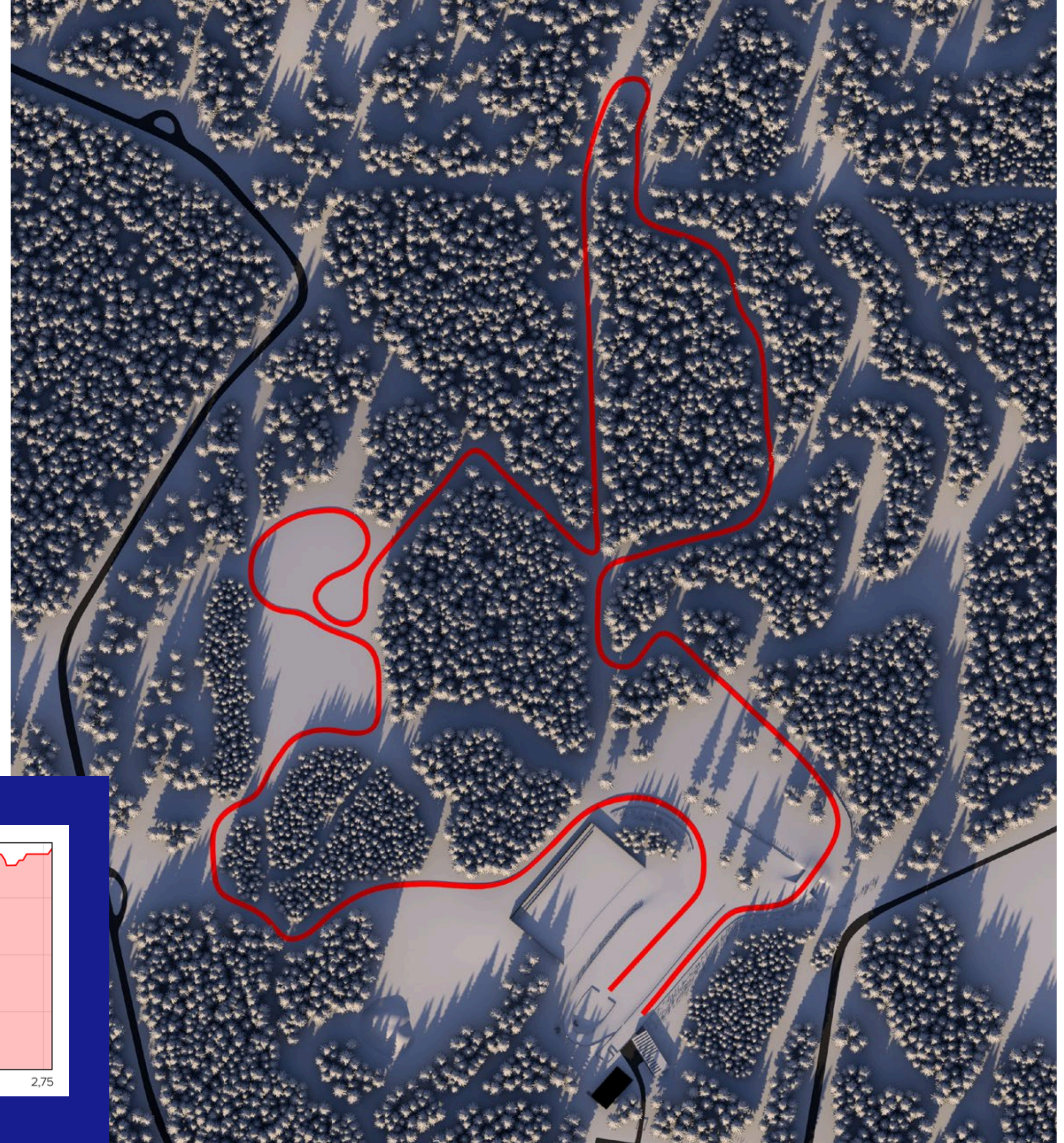
