Cardrona stoked to host once again, the 2019 FIS NZ Freestyle Open! The NZ Freestyle Open is a FIS Continental Cup for Ski & Snowboard Slopestyle & Halfpipe competitors who want to earn FIS points & qualify for FIS World Cup events leading up to the 2022 Beijing Winter Olympics. Slopestyle will include qualifications on Wednesday August 14 & Finals on Thursday August 15. Halfpipe will be in the 22ft Olympic Superpipe on Friday August 16.

WORLD ROOKIE TOUR

The World Rookie Tour is one of the premiere youth international action sport series in the world and now includes both Snowboard and Freestyle Skiing! To be eligible for the World Rookie category, and therefore the WRT Ranking, athletes must only be members of their National Federation. WRT has two divisions, Rookies (born 2004 - 2002) and Groms (2005 - more recent).

FIS ANC (CONTINENTAL CUP)

All events are FIS ANC sanctioned, and riders must be born in 2006 or more recently and hold an active FIS license. These events make up part of the ANC Series hosted between Australia and New Zealand, and the top halfpipe and top slopestyle/big air athletes will earn a personal quota spot in the following seasons World Cup circuit.

RESULTS & AWARDS

A medal ceremony will be hosted in the Cardrona Courtyard at the completion of each day's competition (time TBC). Medals will be awarded for first to third placing for each division, male & female.

ELIGIBILITY

All entrants must be FIS certified and applications must be completed on official FIS registration forms

EVENT ENTRY & LIFT PASSES

All entries are to be on standard FIS entry forms. These are available online at www.snowsports.co.nz. Use separate forms for male & female competitors. Entries for foreign competitors must be submitted by their National Association & all competitors must be FIS registered. Enter online at cardrona.com/events or emailed to events.admin@cardrona.com. Entry fee is \$60 per discipline. Late entries may be accepted at the Team Captains Meeting & will incur a late entry fee of \$20. A deposit of \$25 per bib or \$100 per team will be payable at the Team Captains Meeting before issue. Adult competitor lift passes are available for \$60 per day or \$45 for a child's pass. Coaches up to 8 athletes will receive a complimentary day pass, extra coaching staff are discounted at \$75 per day. All tickets will be distributed at the team captain's meetings.
