REGISTRATION AND TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETING

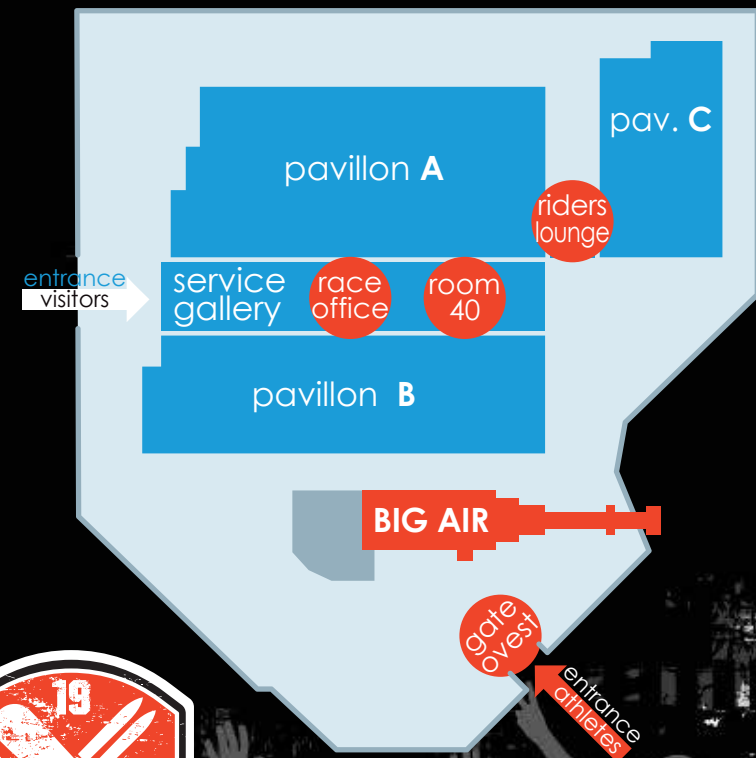
Team registration and fees payment will take place at the event site on Thursday, 31st October in the Race Office, located inside the services gallery at 8 a.m.

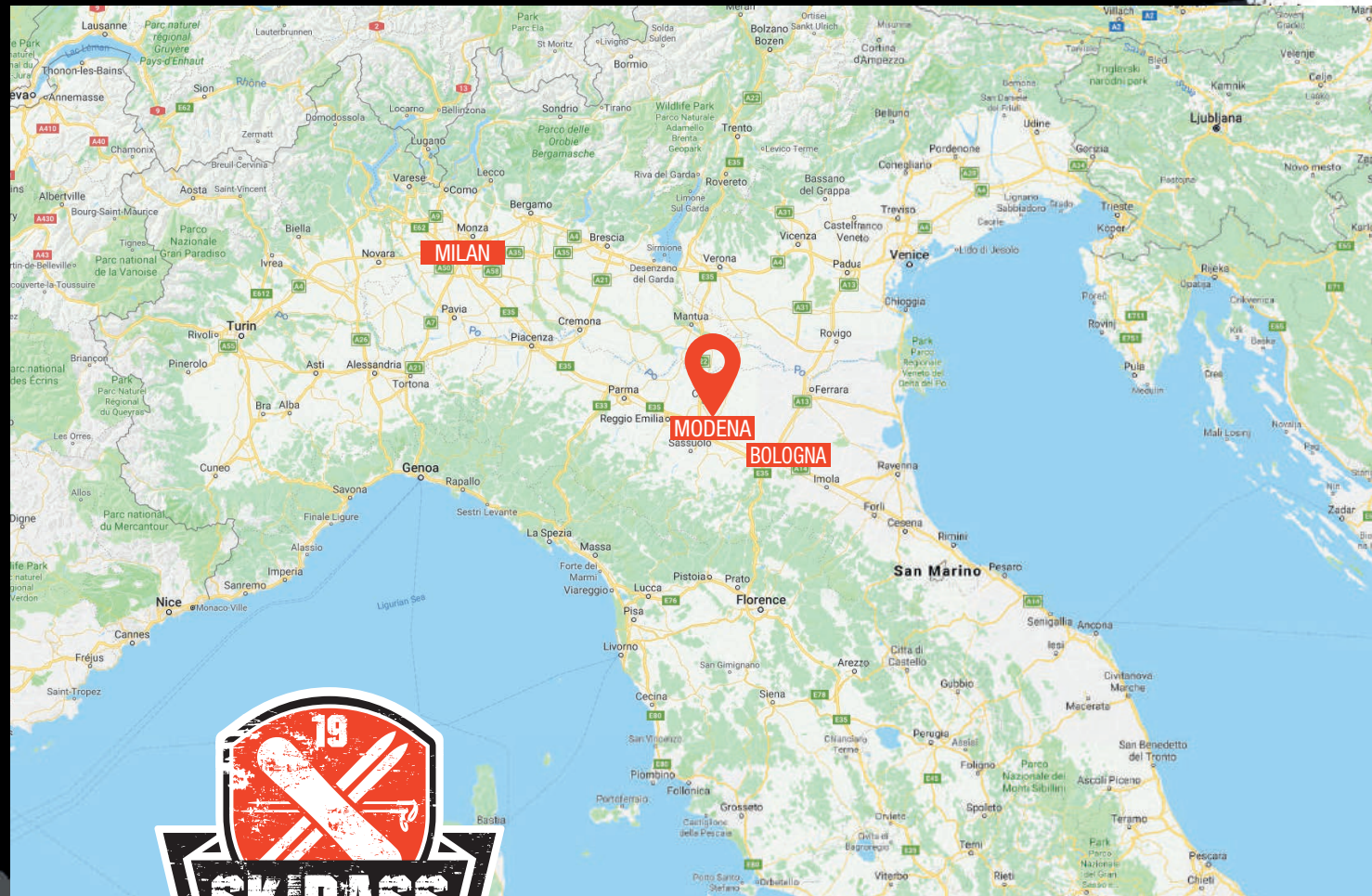

TRANSPORTATION

BY CAR

Modena can be reached by A1 Milano-Napoli motorway, Modena Nord exit (5 km from the town centre and **next to Modenafiere**) or Modena Sud (10 km from the town centre). The town is at the southern end of A22 Modena-Brennero motorway. Modena is 30 minute from Bologna, 45 minutes from Verona, 1h and 15 minutes from Milan Linate and 1h and 50 minutes from Milan Malpensa.

BY TRAIN

Being so near to Bologna (30 minutes train ride) reaching Modena by train is easy. Check timetables and connections on www.trenitalia.it

From 27th October to 7th November it will be possible to take advantage of a 30%

discount travelling with FRECCIAROSSA TRAIN first class and INTERCITY TRAIN second class and a 40% discount traveling with ITALO TRAIN first class train. Regional trains are not included in the offer.

15:15 Guided tour to one of the most beautiful collections of Maserati is hosted in a typical farm producing Parmigiano Reggiano. The Collection contains a number of cars of great value for Maserati, partly because of their unique nature: such as the 6CM from 1936, of which only 27 were made and which dominated European races in the "vetturette" category and won the Targa Florio, and the A6GCS Berlinetta Pininfarina, of which only 4 were made and which won the Mille Miglia for its category three times with its "barchetta" design. Equally important are the Tipo 61 Birdcage - with its exceptional frame comprised of 200 tubes in special alloy welded together for an overall frame weight of 36 kg and its distinctive Drogo bodywork - and the Maserati 420M58 - the famed "Eldorado" used by Stirling Moss in his

battle for one of the top spots during the Monza 500 Miglia. You'll also visit the storage room of Parmigiano Reggiano cheese.

Modena Apennines with the Cimone area, top for winter sports, Pavullo, Zocca and the many villages offer not only unique scenery but also a chance to enjoy sport, excursions and visits to historical towns and castles.

Modena is famous for another proud and unique tradition, that of creating dynamic, stylish sports cars, built for speed. Enzo Ferrari was born here, his house now a museum for his iconic racing cars. In addition to the Enzo Ferrari Museum in Modena and the Ferrari Museum in Maranello, in a radius of just a few kilometres there are several car-related factories, museums and private collections: the Maserati factory and showroom, the Umberto Panini museum of vintage cars and motorbikes, Pagani Automobili, the new Autodromo di Modena racetrack and, in nearby Bologna, Ducati and Lamborghini.

- The ancient heart of the capital of the Dukedom of Este, Modena city of art, embraces architectural jewels admired throughout the world. The Cathedral, together with the Ghirlandina Belltower and Piazza Grande, was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1997, a masterpiece of Italian Romanesque style.
- The seventeenth-century Palazzo Ducale, today home to the Military Academy, used to house the Court of the House of Este, which moved from Modena to Ferrara in 1598. The Estense Gallery and Library, where the most valuable works of art are preserved.

Modena region is synonymous with good food all over the world. A fame that dates back to ancient times due to its genuineness, respect for tradition and preservation of traditional flavours.

- Traditional and innovative menus in restaurants here will delight any palate. Visits can be made to farms throughout the province that produce Parmigiano - Reggiano DOP cheese, Lambrusco di Modena DOP, Aceto Balsamico Tradizionale di Modena DOP and IGP vinegars, Prosciutto di Modena DOP and other local foodstuffs
