The French Ski Federation and the Organizing Committee of the AUDI FIS SKI CROSS WORLD CUP in Val Thorens are pleased to invite all Freestyle Nations to attend this event from December 5th – 7th, 2019. For your information, the reserve day will be Sunday, 8th.

The Organizing Committee will host the event in accordance with the International Ski Competition and World Cup Rules 2019/2020. All national Ski Associations affiliated with the FIS are invited to compete.

1/ PROGRAM

You will find enclosed the provisional program of the event according to the FIS calendar. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify this schedule, depending on the snow conditions or/and the decision of the competition jury.

2/ ARRIVAL

Please note that the appointment for welcome, information & accommodation CHANGE, from the past season and will be at **Sport's Club meeting room (first floor) at "Maison de Val Thorens"** on Monday, 2nd between 02.00 and 06.00 pm and Tuesday, 3rd. Outside these hours, for all your different questions regarding the organization, please steel asking directly at the Club des Sports reception, Opening hours: 09.00 - 12.00 am & 02.00 - 06.00 pm

Each competitor and official will receive a wristband from the OC providing free access to the Sport Centre, the Public Heat Selection (Caron Main Square) and the catering (Official Village) on the QLF & Finals days. A 6-day Val Thorens skipass will be also given to every competitor and official. This wristband must be worn all the time and showed if required.

3/ ACCOMMODATION

Teams will be accommodated in several hotels or residences *** and more, on half-board basis during 6 nights: from the Monday 2nd to the Sunday 8th at FIS rate if needed.

Each team will pay the totality of the accommodation expenses at their arrival and a fully refundable breakage deposit will be required directly by the hotel or residence (major credit card only). Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. **Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, mini bar and pay-TV must be paid by the teams or athletes.**

Please, fill in your accommodation needs on the FIS Online Update System (Team size) with a provisional completed rooming list with any requirements about rooms & place sharing before **October 26th, 2019**.

Please note new rules regarding accommodation:

Accommodation (half-board) and transport on site will be charged at a maximum of CHF 60 per day per person (FIS Rate) to all competitors and team officials.

4/ ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules.

The final composition of your competition team (competitors, officials, and other staff) with your arrival and departure dates (Names, FIS code for the participants and Gender) must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than **November 25th, 2019**.

For any changes notified after this deadline, the organizing committee may invoice the costs incurred for cancelled accommodation to the National Ski Association concerned. Teams or persons who register late have no right to reservation at the FIS rate.

Access to the online registration system is accessed through the FIS Homepage <http://www.fis-ski.com/> Members Section.

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded: <http://www.fis-ski.com/inside-fis/document-library/freestyle-skiing/#deeplink=quotas>

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Freestyle Ski points in one of the valid FIS points list.

The minimum FIS point requirements per FIS Freestyle Ski Cross World Cup event are:

Standards / Requirements	Ski Cross FIS Points
Freestyle FIS Points	100
Alpine FIS points list rank in any event	Top 50

5/ BIBS

All competitors must wear their bibs during the official training, competition, flowers and awards ceremony after the race.

6/ INSURANCE - LIABILITY

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee sponsors, suppliers, their agents, the FIS and the French National Ski Federation decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment during the event.

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The OC, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.
