









AUDI FIS SKI CROSS WORLD CUP January 31th – February 1st 2020

INVITATION

Megève ski resort and the French Ski Federation are pleased to invite all Freestyle Nations to attend the **AUDI FIS Ski Cross World Cup** in Megève from the January 31th to February 1st, 2020.

The organizing committee will host the event in accordance with the International Ski Competition and World Cup Rules 2019/2020. All national Ski Associations affiliated with FIS are invited to compete.

In order to help you to organize your Team's visit, you'll find enclosed some informations concerning the event.

1/PROGRAM:

You will find enclosed the provisional program of the event according to the FIS calendar. The organizing committee reserves the right to modify this schedule, depending on the snow conditions or/and the decision of the jury competition.

2/ARRIVAL

Please note that the appointment for welcome, information and accommodation will be at Sport's Club of Megève – 721 Route Nationale – 74120 MEGEVE (+33 4 50 21 31 50)

On Tuesday 28th January 2020 - opening hour: 09:00 am to 7:00 pm.

3/ ENTRIES

Access to the online registration system is accessed through the FIS Homepage.

The date for the preliminary entries is **December 22th, 2020.**

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules.

The final composition of your competition team (competitors, officials and other staff) with your arrival and departure date must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than **January 21**th, **2020**.

For any changes notified after this deadline, the OC may invoice the costs incurred for cancelled accommodation to the National Ski Association concerned. Teams or person who register late have no

right to reservation at the FIS rate.

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski Cross World Cup must have the minimum required FIS Freestyle ski points on one of the valid FIS points list.

4/ ACCOMODATIONS

Teams will be accommodated in hotel on half-board, from Tuesday 28th January to Sunday 2nd February 2020.

Each team will pay the totality of accommodation expenses at their arrival to the Sport's Club office of Megève.

No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the racers.

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay.

Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, mini-bar and paid-TV must be paid by teams or athletes directly to the hotel.

Please note new rules regarding accommodation:

Accomodation (half-board) will be charged at a maximum of CHF 60/day/person (FIS Rate) to all competitors and team officials.

Lunch will be organized by the OC in the tent at the bottom on the course on Cote 2000.

Please, fill in your accommodation needs on the FIS Online Entry System (team size) with a **provisional** completed rooming list with any requirements about rooms & place sharing **before December 22**th, **2019**.

5/ ACCREDITIONS

All officials and competitors will receive an accreditation card from the Organizing Committee providing free access to the competition site. The card must be worn all the time.

6/ BIBS:

All competitors must wear their bibs during all official training and competition, flowers and awards ceremony after the race.

7/ INSURANCE/LIABILITY

All competitors must have their own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee declines all liability for any accident, lost or damaged equipment, during trainings and competitions.

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The OC, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

8/ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.

9/MEDICAL PLAN

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel and ski patrol from the organizing committee will be responsible for any medical decision and evacuation to the hospital or medical center.

10/PRIZE MONEY

The Prize money will be paid by bank transfer.

11/TRANSPORTATION

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.
