REGISTRATION – ENTRIES:

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. All entries must be done using the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS home page within the mentioned deadlines: www.fis-ski.com/ "Member Section". FIS has established Nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. Entries by mail or fax are no longer accepted.

Definitive registration: January 28th 2020

(By name, confirmation of team size and arrival & departure day)

FIS LICENSE

All athletes are required to have a valid FIS license.

This competition, for both men and women, will be held under the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup rules. All national associations affiliated to the FIS are invited to compete.

According to the FIS international calendar, the competition will take place on February 06th and 09th 2020 following the official program.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Please note that accommodations will be available at the FIS rate for the dates of the program only.

Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS rate. The hotel rates for early arrival or late departure are available upon request.

Teams will be lodged in hotel with half board, from Wednesday night February 05th to Monday morning February 10th 2020 (5 nights at the FIS rate, 60 CHF).

Each coach has to pay his team accommodation expenses directly at the hotels front desk the day of his arrival (Wednesday February 05th). No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the competitors. If they do a reservation the hotel is free to apply the normal hotel prizes.

These conditions will be applied to the members registered on the entry form, which has to be returned to the Organizing Committee before January 06th 2020. Teams wishing to arrive before February 05th should contact Rahel Leis, Tel: +49 7652 1206 8004, sportevent@hochschwarzwald.de

Teams must forward their team accommodation requests using the FIS Online Entry System (ladies/men/officials) until 06.01.2020.

According to the FIS Rules the rates are CHF 60.00/day per team member (athletes and team officials) for accommodation and half board and has to be paid directly at the hotel. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras must be paid by the teams or athletes themselves. "No Shows" become charged to the National Associations directly at the Hotel.

ACCREDITATION

All officials and competitors will receive an accreditation card from the Organizing Committee providing free access to the competition site. The card must be worn all the time.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping control testing maybe conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

The Press Centre will be located at the Haus der Natur (first floor), Dr.-Pilet-Spur 4, 79868 Feldberg (Schwarzwald).

CEREMONIES, PUBLIC BIB DRAW/HEAT PRESENTATION:

The public heat presentation will be held at the Badeparadies Schwarzwald (Am Badeparadies 1, 79822 Titisee-Neustadt) on Friday February 07th 2020 at 7:30 p.m. **(swimwear is recommended!)**

The prize giving will be right after the race in the finish area, Feldberg. The competitors **MUST** wear bibs during the official training, competition and prize giving ceremony!
