1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted by National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules.

DEADLINES

January 13, 2020 : _____Provisional Team Entries (including athletes and officials)

February 12, 2020 : ____Confirmation of the final number of the team (with travel info)

FIS has established Nation Quotas for World Cup. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations.

2. REGISTRATION

Team registration will take place on February 19th, 20th, 2020 from 9:00 to 17:00 at the front desk on the 2nd floor at the Komagatake Grand Hotel.

3. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodations with FIS rates for athletes and officials during the competition are provided as follows;

By the FIS Rule on accommodations, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the Japanese YEN equivalent to CHF50 per day. The FIS Rule on accommodations is applied only to the Komagatake Grand Hotel.

Freestyle Skiing WC Rule 4.4: One single room per country will be provided. An additional single room would be at the rate at CHF 100 per day.

4. TRANSPORTATION

We recommend that you fly to **the Akita Airport**, the nearest airport to the Tazawako Ski Resort. <Free Chartered Bus form the Akita Airport to the hotel by OC>

The Organizing Committee will provide chartered bus between the Akita Airport and the Komagatake Grand Hotel for free for teams. Approx. travel time: 120 min. However, according to flight schedule, you will have to wait at the airport for a while. We'd like to ask for your cooperation.

The Organizing Committee, Semboku city, Akita prefecture, Ski Association of Japan, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athletes, officials or other persons in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.
