2. Rules

- The French Ski Association and la Clusaz Ski Club organise an international Freeski competition, part of the 2020 FIS Freeski Europa Cup Circuit as well as a Fis race competition.
- The competitions will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing.
- This competitions are some Ski Slope Style event for both men and women
- This competitions will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The organizing committee reserve the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather or the decision of the competition jury

3. Entries

Entries will be accepted from the National Ski Associations in accordance with the FIS qualification quotas and rules for the Freeski Europa Cup. Each athlete must have a minimum of 10 FIS points to participate at the Europa Cup. For the FIS Race event, no minimum FIS points are required. The Organizing Committee accept additional athletes above the quota for both races (FIS Race and Europa Cup).

6. Bibs and Helmets

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 10 € per bib. Amount will be refunded by the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

7. Liability

All Athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee, la Clusaz, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible to any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by nay athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event. All participant are urged no to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all time.

8. Accident Insurance

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, la Clusaz, the FIS and the French Ski Association declines any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

9. Accident Protocol

In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital.
