7. BIBS AND HELMETS

SCHLADMING DACHSTEIN

It is mandatory for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets during official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A penalty will be charged to every competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will have to pay a \leq 20,-deposit per bib. The deposit will be refund at the end of the competition when bibs are returned.























8. LIABILITY

All competitors, officials and other members of their National Association who attend or participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organising Committee, Reiteralm, the Austrian Ski Federation, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries occurred or suffered by competitors, officials or any other persons in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.

9. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must be individually medically insured. The Organizing Committee, Reiteralm, the FIS and the Austrian Ski Federation will not be held responsible for accidents and, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

10. ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital.
