

5. Team Captains Meeting

The team Captains meetings will be held in Font-Romeu Casino.

Bibs and Helmets

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 10 € per bib. Amount will be refunded by the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

6. Liability

All Athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee, Font-Rome Pyrénées Resort and Ski Club, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible to any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by nay athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participant are urged no to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all time.

7. Accident Insurance

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, Font-Romeu Resort and Ski Club, the FIS and the French Ski Association declines any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

8. Accident Protocol

In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital.

9. Additionnal Days

Moguls lines could be skied by Teams for training for a week after the competition. Mogul lines have to be maintained by Teams.

Organizing Committee will provide ski pass from 15€ per day per person and accommodation from 30€ per day per person. According to yours needs, Organizing Committee can also manage taylor-made stay.
