TD, TDA, Judges, FIS and other guests will be accommodated at Scandic Lillehammer Hotel.

#### Information from OC according to accommodation SJ Ladies:

Scandic Øyer Hotel will this year be the official hotel for Ski Jumping Ladies due to less accommodation options in Lillehammer this year. The previous hotel, Scandic Hotel Victoria Lillehammer, is **closed due to total renovation**. The hotel is undergoing a total renovation and will be closed from 1st of September 2019 to 2nd of January 2020.











The OC will provide our athletes the possibility to use "Øyer Hallen" for volleyball (walking distance from hotel) and shuttle-service to Lillehammer if needed.

Accommodation costs: The OC will pay for persons within the quota according to FIS Rules.

Price for additional accommodation outside of the quota: 125 CHF per person in double room or apartment (minimum number of persons occurs). Price for additional single rooms outside of the quota: 150 CHF. We retain the right for changes. The costs for additional accommodation must be paid to the OC in the OC Finance Office at the Scandic Lillehammer Hotel during the weekend.

Team Catering facilities are open Friday 10:00-16:00, Saturday and Sunday 09:00-16:00.

Costs for lunch service is 10 CHF per person per day if you haven't ordered and paid full board via the Organizing Committee. Must be ordered through the "doc" above.

Vouchers and bracelets for lunch serving will be handed out to Team Leaders at the OC desk in Scandic Øyer Hotel from Thursday 5/12.

#### 5. Transport

Official airport: Oslo Lufthavn Gardermoen

The OC will provide transportation between the airport and the hotel in Øyer. 1 transport (from and to the airport) free of charge. Price for additional transport: 30 € per person one way (will be deducted from the reimbursement).

**Information to the Shuttle service:** The OC will provide transport between the Scandic Øyer Hotel and the Lysgårdsbakken Ski Jumping Hill (and return) for official trainings and competitions (for shuttle times see the OC desk/info desk at the hotel).

There will also be possibilities for other shuttle-services from Øyer to Lillehammer. Use our OC office in reception for booking or call transportation office.

# 6. Payments: Reimbursement and Prize Money Reimbursement

Accommodation costs: Teams will pay directly in the financial office at Scandic Lillehammer Hotel. Over quota costs are to be paid by credit card only.

#### Income tax information for prize money:

Income tax of European citizens is 15%

Income tax of non-European citizens is 15% (USA 0 %)

Tax will be deducted by the OC according to the Norwegian Foreign Artist Taxation Act, and taxes will be paid by the OC according to the regular tax legislation in Norway.

#### 7. Regulations of radio equipment:

The import, export and the operation of radio equipment in Norway is regulated by national law. Permits for the use of radio transmission equipment must be requested according to national specifications.
