ELIGIBILITY

FIS MASTERS CUP

Racers 30 years and older with an active FIS Masters License are eligible for FIS Masters results/awards.

*****For those renewing FIS Licenses: you MUST renew by January 24th to be on the current points list! If you renew after that date, your points for the start list will be 990.*****

WESTERN REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS/NATIONAL SPEED SERIES

U.S. Ski & Snowboard members and Canadians are eligible for Western Regional and Speed Series results/awards.

- Racers 30 years and older must have an active FIS Masters License and U.S. Ski & Snowboard Masters Membership. Purchase a FIS Masters License when renewing your U.S. Ski & Snowboard Membership at my.ussa.org. If you have already renewed you can add a FIS Masters License here: bit.ly/fismasterslicense
- Racers 18-29 years must have a Masters U.S. Ski & Snowboard Membership.
- SG1 and SG2 both count in the National Speed Series (NSS)
- All four FIS events count for the Western Regional Championships.
