

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# Handout regarding the disbursement of prize money at FIS / IBU World Cup competitions for athletes without residence in Austria (valid from May 2018)

FIS / IBU World Cup organising companies in Austria:

- Austria Ski Veranstaltungsges.m.b.H. (VAT-No. ATU38268708) (abbr.: ASVG)
- Austria Ski Nordic Veranstaltungsges.m.b.H. (VAT-No. ATU45386103) (abbr.: ASN)
- Austria Ski WM und Großveranstaltungsges.m.b.H. (VAT-No. ATU45386201) (abbr.: ASWM)

Foreign athletes need to show their passport (copy) for disbursement of price money (also valid for bank transfer)

General Data Protection Regulation: Information regarding data privacy is provided on our website: <a href="https://www.oesv.at/datenschutz">https://www.oesv.at/datenschutz</a>.

#### VAT applicable for prize money in Austria:

- Athletes participating at a FIS / IBU World Cup competition in Austria are liable to VAT regarding their prize money.
- Prize money has a VAT rate of 20%.
- Legal regulation according to § 3a Art 6 UStG (Austrian Value Added Tax Act): The place of performance of an athlete is defined by the origin of the organising company (ASVG, ASN, ASWM).
- The organising company is liable for the international athlete's VAT and therefore pays the international athlete's VAT to the Austrian tax authorities (reverse charge system).
- Legal regulation according to § 19 Art 1 UStG (Austrian Value Added Tax Act): If the supplier of the service (=athlete) has neither domicile (seat) nor residence or a fixed establishment regarding the service supply in Austria, the service recipient (= organizer, e.g. ASVG, ASN, ASWM) is liable for VAT. This applies because the organiser itself is a taxable entity.
- As a result, the international athlete does not have to take action (= pay VAT by her/himself). VAT liability in Austria is met by the organising company. If the athlete has a residence within the European Union, there still remains responsibility for declaring the price money via "Recapitulative Statement".

#### Income tax - Withholding tax for international athletes in Austria:

- The Austrian organising company has to withhold 20 % of the international athlete's net prize money and pay it to the tax authorities.
- Legal regulation according to § 99 Art 1 lit 1 in connection with § 100 EStG (Austrian Income Tax Act): The international athlete is subject to limited income tax liability, provided she/he receives remuneration in Austria for service as a self-employed person.
- The organising company (e.g. ASVG, ASN, etc.) is liable for withholding and paying the withholding tax. Deduction of tax has to be carried out at that point of time when the prize money is disbursed to the athlete.
- As a result, the international athlete does not have to take action (= pay income tax by her/himself). Income tax liability in Austria is met by the organising company.
- USA athletes are tax exempt according to the double taxation agreement between Austria and USA, provided that the US-athlete's income, including refunded costs, will not exceed

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US\$ 20.000,00 in Austria per annum (Art 7 DBA USA). Income tax at a rate of 20% will be deducted and paid to the Austrian tax authorities by the Austrian organizer. Information regarding tax refund see below.

- Hungarian athletes with residence in Hungary are tax exempt according to the double taxation agreement between Austria and Hungary. Income tax at a rate of 20% will be deducted and paid to the Austrian tax authorities by the Austrian organizer. Information regarding tax refund see below.

- Another option provides § 102 Art 1 lit 3 EStG to request reimbursement or reduction of withholding tax from price money via application under certain circumstances. Tax office "Finanzamt Graz-Stadt, Betriebsveranlagungsteam Ausländerreferate" is responsible for such applications. Address: Conrad von Hötzendorf-Straße 14-18, A-8010 Graz. It is highly recommended to contact a tax consultant in advance, because this is seldom the better option.



#### Ladies and Gentlemen,

the interference-free operation of radio systems and telecommunications systems within Austria is our concern and also our legal mandate under the Telecommunications Act 2003 (TKG 2003).

In order to ensure an interference-free operation of radio systems, all frequencies are to be coordinated – and the operation of such radio equipment must also be approved by the Telecommunication Authority.

Particularly at large events in strongly populated urban areas, we must adhere to the regulatory law and in the interest of all radio systems users, where applicable we maintain the right to intervene in the case of unauthorized radio equipment.

The operation of radio systems in Austria is generally subject to approval. The following classes are however excluded from an individual approval, generically approved radio systems such as the category Class 2, CB radio equipment (FSB-LN001), SRD radio systems (FSB-LD074), radio microphones (FSB-LD048) as well as the categorisation "Class 1" radio systems.

Please remember that the operation of radio equipment **without** the proper frequency coordination and a valid operating permit can cause harmful interference to other radio stations and therefore is strictly prohibited.

We are legally commissioned to place unauthorized radio equipment out of operation and in following steps seize them. This is followed by administrative penalty fines of up to EURO 4,000, - including the asset forfeiture of the radio systems (§ 109 TKG).

§§ 112 and 113	Telecommunications Authorities and the division of responsibilities.	
§ 114	Participation of the Public Security Bodies.	

We urgently ask all radio equipment users to contact the Telecommunications Authority regarding the usability of their systems.

It is imperative to comply to the instructions of the Telecommunications Authorities of the Radio Monitoring Center Carinthia.
