Grom Race Age Categories-

Grom 1- Born in the years- 2007-2008 *If you are born after these years of birth you are too young to enter.

Grom 2- Born in the years- 2005-2006 * If you are born before these years you will need to be FIS Registered.

HOTHAM MEDICAL FACILITIES

Hotham has its own medical centre that is staffed all season and has out of hour staff (nurse & doctor) on standby. The medical centre has an ambulance stationed on mountain all season and the closest hospital if needed is approx. 2hr away in Wangaratta. Hotham has its own helipad if the injury or illness be so severe to need an air lift off mountain.

TRANSPORTATION BY CAR

Mt Hotham can be accessed via car from Bright or Omeo. If driving, in Australia's alpine regions it is compulsory to carry Diamond Shape tire chains and fit them when directed. Failure to do so may result in a fine. Resort Entry is also applicable if you are parking within the resort. It is best to pre purchase online via the following link: [All vehicles must be parked in appropriate areas. For more information please head to hotham.com.au](https://www.hotham.com.au)

From Melbourne

1. Take the Hume Hwy to Wangaratta then the Great Alpine Road direct to Hotham, or the Snow Road via Milawa & Oxley to Myrtleford & Hotham. Travel time around 5 hours.
2. Take the Princes Hwy to Bairnsdale, then the Great Alpine Road direct to Mount Hotham. Travel time around 5.5 hours.

From Sydney

Take the Hume Hwy to Albury-Wodonga and follow the snow signs to Yackandandah then turn off to Myrtleford. At Myrtleford turn onto the Great Alpine Road to Bright then Harrierville and Hotham. Travel time around 9 hours.

From Adelaide

Take the Mallee Highway to Ouyen, connect to the Murray Valley Highway to Swan Hill, the Midland Highway to Shepparton, then take the Hume Highway to Wangaratta, followed by the Great Alpine Road direct to Hotham. Travel time around 12 hours.

From Brisbane

From Brisbane drive south along the Newell Highway across NSW via Tocumwal and Cobram then across to Wangaratta. Take the Great Alpine Road direct to Hotham via Bright and Harrierville. Travel time around 15 hours.

From Newcastle

Take the Sydney Newcastle Freeway, connecting with the South Western Freeway and Hume Highway to Goulburn and Albury-Wodonga. Then follow the snow signs to Yackandandah then turn off to Myrtleford. At Myrtleford turn onto the Great Alpine Road to Bright then Harrierville and Hotham. Travel time around 10 hours.





TRANSPORTATION BY AIR

Direct flights from Sydney to Mount Hotham Airport are available through private charter. Visit the Hotham Website (Plan My Trip Section, then Travel to Hotham) to see which charter companies are available or contact Hotham Holidays directly to book for you.

Qantas Airlines run flights from Sydney to Albury. Flights are limited so please check well in advance. From Albury, transport can be arranged through SnowBall Express coach link. A Snowpass card is also required for a lift ticket product to be loaded onto. Please purchase one for \$5 with lift ticket. If you lose your snowpass card, they can be repurchased for \$5 at multiple locations on mountain.

All participants will need a valid lift ticket in order to access lifts and the skiing/riding area. Please be sure to keep your lift ticket on you at all times.

Fast skiing/riding is only permitted on training runs or on the race track. Anyone found skiing fast on public runs or in slow areas will lose their skiing privileges.

The Alpine Responsibility Code must be obeyed at all times.

Please be aware of ski area signage and notifications by Ski Patrol which are clearly marked.
