

## ACCOMMODATIONS

#### OFFICIAL ARRIVING DAY: 20TH JANUARY 2020 OFFICIAL DEPARTURE DAY: 27TH JANUARY 2020

As per the FIS Snowboard World Cup Rule on accommodation and half pension, all competitors and team officials within the Quota numbers will pay the Canadian equivalent of 80 CHF per night.

Teams will be hosted for lodging at the Inn at Big White and provided breakfast and dinner at various restaurants throughout the Resort, from Monday January 20th to Monday January 27th.

To reserve your rooms with the FIS Rate please contact Cathy Astofooroff at <a href="mailto:sbxbookings@canadasnowboard.ca">sbxbookings@canadasnowboard.ca</a>.

All accommodation payments have to be made by the respective responsible team coach on arrival day. No reservation, nor payment will be accepted from the competitors. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

Any cancellations from 12th January 2020 or later will not be refunded. All cancellations earlier than the 13th January 2020 will be refunded in full.

Earlier arrivals or later departures than the official arriving/departure day will receive a 15% discounted rate on the hotel's retail rates.

Note: Condos and houses and other accommodation outside of the FIS rate can be booked at a 15% discounted rate. ## BIBS

The competitors must wear bibs during training, competition and award ceremonies. \$20 Canadian bib deposit is to be paid per rider bib, in cash, at the Race Office at the Team Captains Meetings.
