ACCOMMODATIONS

OFFICIAL ARRIVAL: WEDNESDAY FEB. 26, 2020 OFFICIAL DEPARTURE: MONDAY MAR. 2, 2020

The official hotel for the 2020 Alpine Snow TKO World Cup is Blue Mountain Resort 190 Gord Canning Drive, Blue Mountains, Ontario, Canada.

As per the FIS Snowboard World Cup Rule on accommodation and half pension, all competitors and team officials within the Quota numbers will pay the Canadian equivalent of 80 CHF per night.

Teams will be hosted for lodging at the Blue Mountain Inn at Blue Mountain Resort and provided breakfast & dinner in the identified catering room in the Inn from arrival on Wednesday February 26th until departure on Monday March 2nd.

Teams must confirm their entries by name and rooming lists for accommodation no later than 5 PM EST on January 31, 2020 by contacting the race office at <u>alpineworldcup@canadasnowboard.ca</u>.

Payment will be requested by bank wire before the arrival for the dates and numbers of athletes and officials submitted on the official entry/team size form made by the respective responsible team coach. No reservation, nor payment will be accepted from the competitors.


> Any cancellations from 17th of February 2020 or later will not be refunded. All cancellations earlier than the 16th February 2020 will be refunded in full.

At the time of check-in at the host hotel, a fully-refundable damage deposit of \$50 CAD will be required for each room, payable on any major credit card. Each National Sport Association will be held responsible for any damage incurred during their stay. Any additional expenses apart from accommodation will be charged to guests directly by the hotel.



MEALS

Commencing with dinner on Wednesday February 26th and ending with breakfast on Monday March 2nd. The meal plan will be offered at the host hotel. Complete information will be provided upon teams' registration.



TRANSPORTATION





The Organizing Committee, Ontario Snowboard, Blue Mountain Resort, Canadian Snowsports Association, FIS, Canada Snowboard, sponsors and suppliers decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment, and second and third party claims during the event.

In the case of accidents on course during the event, medical personnel from the OC and Ski Patrol personnel will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital in co-operation with the National Sport Associations' medical personnel identified on the entry form.
