FIS and Europa Cup Slopestyle Landgraaf November 20th & 21st 2019

1. General information

The FIS competition and Europa Cup Snowboard Slopestyle in SnowWorld Landgraaf will be held in the existing, but renewed and well maintained park. Having these competitions on a limited event area calls for an adjusted format. It is therefore that riders will have separate runs on kickers and on rails.

Each rider will have two runs on the kickers and two runs on rails. The best score of each will be added together for a final result. This format will be used for both qualifications and finals.

The OC provides prize money with a total of € 3.500 to make these competitions even more interesting for teams to come to the Netherlands.

SnowWorld Landgraaf offers perfect conditions to start the season, as teams are welcome in the excellent gym (free of charge) in the same facility and numerous outdoor activities can be planned for extra training.

In the previous edition of the Europa Cup, we welcomed almost 100 athletes. Anticipating on that large amount, we will run the competitions with a double up judging format in order to make them run as smooth and quick as possible.

Training will be planned in heats, so each team will have a designated training time on the training days. The OC will, if the snow quality allows it, make sure there are several rails and jib features available outside of these training times.

2. Entries and important forms

3. Registration

Team registration will take place daily starting Sunday, November 17th, from 15.00 to 20.00 at the Race Office in SnowWorld Landgraaf.

4. Accommodation

Room prizes for full board at the SnowWorld Landgraaf hotel are as follows:

4 in a room: €85 pp/pn
3 in a room: €90 pp/pn
2 in a room: €95 pp/pn
1 in a room: €125 pp/pn

For teams staying in another location a daily fee of €50 is charged for slope access, lunch and dinner.

The city tax, €2,50 per person per night is not included in the rate.

Accommodation at these rates will be provided for the nights of November 17th to November 21st 2019.

Each team will be held responsible for any damage occurred during the stay.

5. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

6. Meals

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided, starting with Dinner on Sunday November 17th up to and including breakfast and lunch on Friday, November 22th.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be organized at SnowWorld Landgraaf.

After the competition on Thursday 21st, SnowWorld will organize a goodbye dinner.

7. Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during all competition and award ceremonies.

8. Accident Insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, SnowWorld Landgraaf, the FIS and the Netherlands Ski Federation decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

9. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, SnowWorld Landgraaf, the Netherlands Ski Federation, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

10. Official Notice Board

The official Notice Board will be located at the Race Office at SnowWorld Landgraaf.

11. Training

Training is provided by the OC on Monday November 18th and Tuesday November 19th. In SnowWorld Landgraaf a professional gym is situated. For athletes and coaches there is free entrance on the 17th, 18th, 19th, 20th and 21st of November.

In SnowWorld Landgraaf there also is the possibility to book a massage. Reservation is required.

12. Event fee

Only for competition days an event fee of € 25 per competitor is charged, to be paid at the race-office, on the day prior to the event the latest.
