Please submit the provisional entry with anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) by December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019. The final entry with number of your competition team and names of participants (including competitors and official) must be submitted to the organizers no later than January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.
