Please submit the provisional and final entries with a FIS Entry Form (ICR Art. 215) to Lyndsay Gang at Lyndsay.gang@usskiandsnowboard.org. Final entries must be submitted no later than 14 days prior to the first day of official training.

Provisional Entry Deadline: February 2, 2020

Final Entry Deadline: February 16, 2020

All competitors must hold current FIS memberships.

2. ACCOMMODATIONS

Teams are responsible for booking their own accommodations.

4. ONSITE REGISTRATION/ACCREDITATION

All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the Registration Area for check-in before proceeding to the competition venue. All fees will be collected upon check-in. Please see schedule for registration times.

Athletes will receive complimentary lift tickets for all competition days.

All Coaches with current FIS memberships and included within the official team entry will receive complimentary lift tickets for training and competition days.
