Speed Nation Beaver Valley is the second Snowboardcross stop of the Speed Nation SBX Tour.

Speed Nation Beaver Valley brings together the best SBX athletes in North American to compete in a Snowboardcross event in two days.

THE RESORT

Beaver Valley is located on the 30 minutes outside of Collingwood and less than two hours from Toronto Pearson International Airport. Set overlooking the Beaver Valley offers twenty six groomed trails, progression and terrain parks, mogul course as well as a dedicated SBX track. Their facilities include a high capacity snowmaking system allowing for earlier opening dates as well as four efficient lifts and club house lodges. A team of expert builders will complete the building of the Beaver Valley NorAm track with oversight provided by Canada Snowboard and Snowboard Ontario.

International Athletes Notice

In order to confirm your registration, the Event Organizers need to receive a written confirmation from your National Snowboard Association confirming that you are in good standing, prior to your arrival at the event. The confirmation letter can be submitted by email to: janetrichter@ontariosnowboarders.ca

Note: A valid FIS License is required to register.

Eligibility

Competitors must meet the following age limit in order to compete:

SBX 15 years+ by December 31, 2019

Competitors must also hold a valid FIS License. Canadian athletes can purchase FIS license, SAIP insurance and Provincial or Territorial Snowboard Association Membership before registering through your Provincial or Territorial Association.

Athlete Lift Tickets: Included in Registration Fee

Spectator Lift Tickets: \$55.00 per day + HST

Coaches Lift Tickets: Only coaches that are registered will be provided with complimentary lift ticket to coach (ratio 6:1)

CANADIAN COACHES REGISTRATION

All Canadian coaches at events must register and meet the Canadian Minimum Coach Certification Standards.

REFUND POLICY

Event Registration Fee refunds require the approval of the Snowboard Ontario Executive Director.

The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in event – must be confirmed with doctor's note.

Refunds for cash or cheque transactions must be refunded by cheque.

Credit card refunds must be processed via card transaction credit.

Lift Tickets are not refundable.
