Dear Snowboard Friends!

Welcome to the **FIS Snowboard Premium Europa Cup Big Air**
to be held on 28th - 29th of February 2020 at the historic location of Vorobiovy Gory, Moscow!

Russian Snowboard Federation will host the event in accordance with the FIS International Competition Rules (ICR) and FIS Continental Cups Rules. All athletes who are qualified according to the FIS Rules for the Snowboard Europa Cup are invited to take part in the competition.

1. PASSPORT and VISA

A foreign visitor traveling to Russia must have a passport **valid for at least next 6 months after the date of departure from Russia.**

Please note: Russian Consulates usually also require that any foreign visitor travelling to Russia should have a valid travel insurance (for action sports and/or professional/competitive sports).

2. Entries and important forms

Entries will be accepted from National Ski and Snowboard Associations in accordance with the FIS quotas and FIS Continental Cup Rules. Please use the official entry form (ICR art. 215).

3. Event Participation Fee

According to the FIS SB Continental Cup Rule (EC 2.6) a Participation Fee of **CHF 50** per each competitor, covering both training and competition days, will be charged.

This amount has to be paid to the Organizing Committee at the registration at the Race Office starting on Thursday, February 27th, 2020

Please note: Payments will be accepted only in cash!

Euros, Swiss Francs, and Rubles will be accepted but change will be given in Rubles.

4. Registration

Team registration will take place starting on Thursday, February 27th, 2020, at the Race Office.



5. Accommodation

As per the FIS CoC Rule on accommodation (double room, half-board), each participant will pay a maximum of **CHF 80** per day/person.

The amount is payable upon registration at the Race Office.

Accommodation at FIS rate will be provided from arrival on Thursday, **27th February, 2020**, until departure on Sunday, **1st March, 2020**.

*Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay.

*The OC will provide accommodation guidance for those who arrive before the 27th February, 2020.

6. Ground Transportation

The Organizing Committee will organize transport (shuttles) from the airport to the official hotel "Aerostar" as well as shuttles to competition venue and back to official hotel.

7. Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be organized at the hotel starting with dinner on Thursday **27th February, 2020** and finishing with breakfast on Sunday, **1st March, 2020**.

During the event the Organizing Committee will provide competitors and coaches with drinking water, hot tea and light snacks at the event venue.

8. Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during all official trainings, competitions and award ceremonies.

9. Accident insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, Russian Snowboard Federation, sponsors, suppliers, their agents and the FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

10. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, «Roza Khutor» Ski Resort, Russian Snowboard Federation, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athletes, officials or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

11. Official notice board

The official notice board will be located at the Race Office at "Aerostar" hotel - as well as at the event welcome desk at the official hotel.

12. Competition & Training Schedule

Training & Competition times are according to the official sports schedule of the event.



13. Prize fund

Total of EUR 20 000 (Men EUR 15 000, Ladies EUR 5 000) and also optional in-kind prizes.

14. Announcements

An English-speaking announcer will be provided by the OC for the event.

15. Medical and Anti-Doping

Anti-doping control may be conducted on location - as requested by official Doping Control officers for each gender of competitors.
