# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS



The following protocol was drawn up by the organisers of the French Ski World Cup (Val d'Isere, Courchevel, Chamonix) in collaboration with the French Ski Federation and in liaison with the national authorities (Ministry of Health, Ministry of Sport and the ARS) and the local authorities (Prefecture of Savoie and Haute-Savoie and the Community of Communes of the Chamonix Mont-Blanc Valley).

The principles, to date :

- Limitation of interactions with the implementation of sanitary bubbles
- A hermetic racing bubble with very strict protocols
- Respect for physical distance and barrier gestures in all areas
- Mask must be worn in all indoor and outdoor areas.
- A policy of nasopharyngeal RT-PCR virological tests set up for the bubble races, organisation and the press

# TESTING POLICY



# TESTING POLICY (cf. test protocol)



- Strict adherence to Health Ministry and ARS protocols.
- Required testing before the event as part of event rules to be able to pick up one's accreditation.
- 1 nasal RT-PCR negative test required less than 72 hours before the start of the event for anyone going to the event location to pick up their accreditation.
- Turn in a filled out and signed FIS questionnaire to pick up one's accreditation.
- The organizing committee recommends that all people working at the event download the TOUSANTICOVID mobile app.
- Further details regarding the event's testing policy are provided in the adjoining medical protocols document.

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

## Goals and basic principles:

Protect the health of participating athletes and everyone involved in the event, as well as ensure that all races go as planned



### PROTECTION

Wearing a mask is required Use hand sanitizer frequently



### DISTANCING

Always maintain proper physical distancing



### SAFETY & HYGIENE

Do not interact with the general public (autographs and selfies are strictly forbidden)

### TESTING

Follow Covid-19 testing protocols

### CONFINEMENT

Stay withing one's sanitary  
bubble and avoid all  
unplanned or unsafe outside  
contact



### TRANSPARENCY

Alert the doctors and  
organizing committee of any  
symptoms Identify any contacts  
at risk



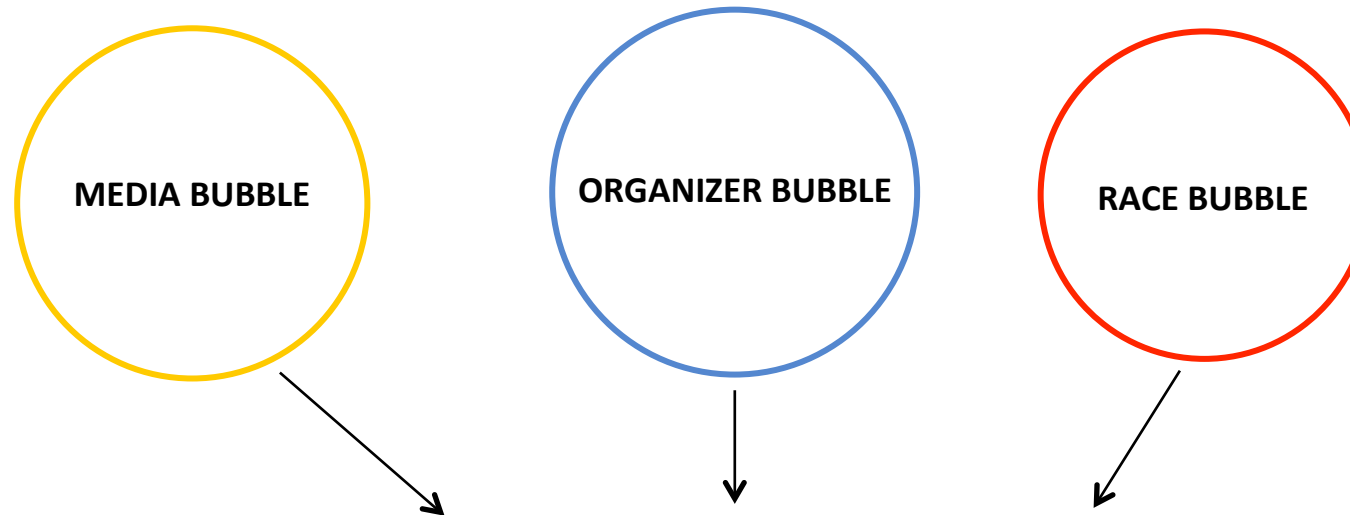
### VENTILATION

Ventilate any and all enclosed  
spaces



# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

**Caution in case of failure to comply with the sanitary protocol**

***Exclusion from the event: the rest of this protocol is everyone's responsibility.***

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

Zone : Waiting areas / Changing tents / Warm up tent

- All areas will be organized to limit the flow of people as much as possible.
- Foot traffic protocol with a specific direction for traffic to follow.
- Limit the number of 2 people in each area.
- Limit the use of these areas to the race and organizer sanitary bubbles.
- No volunteers are allowed inside any of these three areas, only outside/ around the perimeter to conduct safety/security/badge checks.

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Equipment preparation areas

- A waxing box for one Nation or the possibility to share the box with another Nation provided that both Nations are in the same hotel.
- Limit the number of people in the stall
- Limit these spaces to the race bubble

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Start & Finish areas / Mixed zone

- All areas will be organized to limit the flow of people as much as possible
- Foot traffic protocol with a specific direction for traffic to follow.
- Limit the number of people in each area by m<sup>2</sup> per person.
- Limit the use of these areas to the race, organizer, and media sanitary bubbles, only outside to control access.
- No volunteers are allowed inside any of these three areas, only outside/ around the perimeter to conduct safety/security/badge checks.

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Team Hospitality

- Arrangement of traffic lanes, seating areas and other areas limiting flows
- One-way entry and exit differentiated and identified
- Installation of a traffic direction
- Limit the number of staff within the spaces based on the square meter per person.
- Limit this space to the race bubble
- Catering in compliance with health regulations
- Recommend individual portions and provision of bottles
- Provision of hydro-alcoholic gels.
- Cleaning of the space: Disinfection in the evening after the departure of the last occupant, in the morning before the arrival of the occupants and at the time of slope inspection (2 slope inspection for technical disciplines) + immediately upon release from any seated area.
- Reinforce access control at the entrance

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Accommodation & meals

- Teams housed on the same floor, access to hotel facilities by stairs (to avoid lifts); try to separate teams from other hotel guests.
- Keep distance between twin beds
- If possible, separate access for the team
- Additional cleaning / disinfection plans prior to arrival
- Hand disinfection system and paper towels available in several places in the accommodation, including the rooms.
- Avoid cleaning rooms when staff members are present. (Avoid contact with cleaning staff).

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Accomodation & meals

- Provide isolation rooms if necessary
- Rules for the use of common facilities (gymnasium, meeting rooms)
- Separate the dining rooms/catering areas from other hotel guests with sufficient space
- Prepare as much as possible the catering room(s) before the teams arrive.
- Sufficient water/drinks already on the tables
- Buffet meals are not permitted
- Favour a self-service of already prepared plates or table service

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Transport services / Car Park

- Regular cleaning of transport vehicles
- Wipes and hydro-alcoholic gels available in all vehicles.
- Wearing a mask is compulsory for the driver and passengers.
- One designated driver per car/bus/truck

## Zone : Lift access

- Wearing a mask is obligatory on all ski lifts.
- The seat of the charlift will be organised in groups
- Regular disinfection of the means of transport in accordance with the recommendations of the Ministry of Transport and/or the ski area operator.

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Accreditation Zones

- Accreditation for teams (athletes and staff) can be collected by appointment at the team hotel or at the “Majestic”. Area reserved exclusively for the race bubble. One person per team must come to collect the accreditations and identification armbands (ex: Team Captain or Head Coach). The accreditations of the Guests will also be collected by this same person.
- Withdrawal of accreditations for persons belonging to the Blue Bubble at the Sports Club or at the finish area of the Ski World Cup.
- Collection of media accreditations at the “Majestic”
- In all areas :
  - ✓ Provision of a hydroalcoholic gel
  - ✓ Instead of one direction of traffic
  - ✓ Regular disinfection of these areas

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Race office & Team Captain Meeting

- Race office at the Majestic in a limited access area to the race bubble
- TCM is online meeting, presential reserved for the Organising Committee, FIS staff, doctors, race office (secretary and technician), and wiss timing.
- Access control at the entrance of the TCM which will be at the jury room in the finish area of the competition => no public
- No cocktail after the TCM
- Live broadcast of the TCM
- Online program on the website of the Kandahar Ski World Cup after the MCT

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Meeting room (Jury)

- Limit the number of people
- Jury room: arrival area in the Shed
- Provision of hydro-alcoholic gel and disinfecting wipes
- Regular cleaning of this room

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Medias Center

- Spaces will be re organised in order to limit the flow of people.
- Installation of a traffic direction
- Limit the number of staff within the spaces based on the square meter per person.
- Limit this space to the media bubble
- Press conference in camera and webcast on the Kandahar Ski World Cup website
- Limit the number of journalists during the event

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Bib draw

- Cancellation of the bib drawing ceremony in Chamonix

## Zone : Winner photos / Official awards ceremonies

- Prize giving at the end of the races in the finish area
- Respect for social distancing between the athletes themselves and between athletes and journalists during the podium photo shoot.
- No shaking hands when handing out trophies
- Athletes must stay on the podium
- No public ceremony in Chamonix but only after the race in the air at the finish line

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## Zone : Radio center

- Disinfect radios regularly
- Only one volunteer assigned to the radios, wearing a mask and gloves.

## Zone : TV Compound

- Limited access to TV only (IN FRONT)

Wearing a mask is obligatory
