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GENERAL INFO

This year's edition of the Ski World Cup in Alta Badia will take place exclusively behind closed doors, without any live audience. Only people with accreditation will have access to the event. All participants will be registered on our EventBuilder System with full name, phone number and group/bubble affiliation.

The following people will be granted access to the event:

YELLOW GROUP/BUBBLE Media (Broadcasters, Journalists) Photographers,	200 Pax	Negative Covid test (result of PCR/antigen to be uploaded on FIS Passport) + on site rapid antigen test.
BLUE GROUP/BUBBLE Local Organising Committee, Officials, Personnel, Workforce, Volunteers, Suppliers	400 Pax	Part of the STAFF, at the discretion of the Organiser, will have to undergo a rapid antigen test.
Total	950 Pax	tbc

In addition to the accreditation, every member of the red and yellow group will get a dedicated armband associated to the correct bubble to guarantee straightforward identification.

It is expected that all population groups and persons make their own arrangements to have an up-to-date PCR test or antigen test result and have it updated on the FIS Passport before arrival at the Event, to facilitate their access and accreditation. More details will be listed below.

The whole event will be equipped with the necessary safety devices (dispensers, information signage) according to the current legislation. An outside firm, specialised in health care and supervised by the OC and the local health authorities, will be entrusted with such aspect.

Every single environment/area will constantly be cleaned and sanitized by professionals. All accesses will be under surveillance by security.









GENERAL BEHAVIOUR

"Act as you want others to act"

Take care about your behaviour and act as a role model during the whole event!

- Daily health self-reflection (If you feel sick: report it (procedure below) and stay in your room)
 - Do not travel to the event venue if you feel sick or have any COVID-19 symptoms
 - Temperature will be measured every morning by access control before entering the event

> Hygiene

- Wash your hands regularly and properly
- Use provided disinfection dispensers regularly and properly
- Wearing of masks/mouth-nose face covering mandatory in all areas
- Avoid handshaking
- Cover your mouth and nose with your bent elbow or tissue when you cough or sneeze

Avoid contacts

- Direct contacts should be limited as much as possible. This applies also for time off the venue!
 - In case of contacts, the general rules and national regulations of distancing and wearing masks must be respected and followed
- Maximise distance between you and people from different "bubbles"
- ➤ People from Red & Yellow Bubble, who wish to access the Event must have and present a negative Covid-19 PCR Test or a negative Antigen Test carried out prior to arrival at the Event for the first time.
- ➤ It is expected that all population groups and persons make their own arrangements to have an up-to-date PCR/Antigen test result on arrival at the Event, to facilitate their access and accreditation
- > PCR/Antigen test results may not be older than 72h
- An antibody positive serological blood test will not be recognised as a valid test result
- Violations will be treated strictly















ACCREDITATION

ACCREDITATION PROCEDURE (PRE-EVENT)

Every person requesting accreditation for the event is required to report, by filling out a registration form, the state of health before arrival on site.

The procedure will be divided in three different stages:

Stage 1 – accreditation request

- Red Bubble: All members from the Red Bubble will have to apply to the event through the usual FIS Entry Form.
- Yellow Bubble: Members from the Yellow Bubble will have to submit the accreditation request to the organizing committee by using the Event Builder WEB registration form available at the following link: https://my.eventbuilder.it/myopportunities/c3523a09-3575-41bc-a790-f2145d20e070
- ➤ Blue Bubble: Members from the Blue Bubble will have to submit the accreditation request to the organizing committee directly.

The assessment outcome will be communicated through an email sent to the address indicated on the registration form.

Stage 2 - Gathering of COVID 19 information

- Red and Yellow Bubble: Every member of the Red and Yellow Bubble will have to have a negative PCR-Test/Antigen-Test result and have it uploaded on the FIS Passport.
- ➤ Blue Bubble: The <u>EventBuilder-Covid-19</u> form allows the gathering of data obtained through the compilation of the form submitted to all accredited people whose request was accepted in stage 1.
 - The information to be collected will be aligned with the guidelines and specific needs of the National Health Authorities. Among the collected data there will be information regarding date of arrival and date of departure in order to be able to administer the scheduling of Covid-19 rapid antigen test.

All data will be collected in a reserved area on EventBuilder. Given the nature of the collected data, access to the reserved area is granted only to specific users whose involvement is fundamental (e.g. health-care provider). The gathering, usage and retention of personal data will be regulated in accordance to the GDPR.















The compilation request will be sent via email or WhatsApp to all people requesting accreditation.

➤ Groups

The requested forms can be compiled according to the following methods:

- Every single person declares its own state of health
- The declaration of the state of health of the whole group is charged to the one person who is responsible and authorised by the group

Stage 3 – Onsite workflow; Procedure for accreditation pick-up

People, who requested accreditation – stage 1 – and got through stage 2, will get an appointment via email/SMS to undergo the rapid antigen test.

The OC's person in charge will evaluate the test and issue the final approval to pickup the accreditation (Procedure below).

ACCREDITATION PICK UP

- Only one person per team/group is allowed to collect accreditations
- Distribution of accreditation and armbands will be held at designated pick up point

- Accreditation will only be handed out with the confirmation of the negative COVID-19 test result received by mail/SMS.
- Check-in in allocated hotel only after pick-up of accreditation
- For Media: separated accreditation for races in Val Gardena and Alta Badia
















COVID-19 TEST CENTRE & TESTING PROCEDURE



- The TEST CENTRE is located at "VILLAGGIO ALPINO F. TEMPESTI", Strada La Siëia 11, I-39033 Corvara in Badia Opening Hours
 - Sunday, December 13th from 8:30am to 12pm and from 1:30pm to 6pm
 - Monday, December 14th from 9am to 12pm
 - Thursday, December 17th from 10am to 12pm and from 1pm to 6pm
 - Friday, December 18th from 11am to 12pm and from 1pm to 7pm
 - Saturday, December 19th from 10:30am to 12pm and from 1:30 pm to 7pm
 - Sunday, December 20th from 7am to 9am
- The running of a rapid antigen test, in addition to the PCR/Antigen test carried out before arrival in Alta Badia, is mandatory.

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- On-site antigen testing arranged by the organiser available <u>only upon online</u> <u>reservation</u> through the Event Builder System.
- ➤ The testing service will be organised by the local health authorities in collaboration with the Croce Bianca Alto Adige. The contact person will be Dr Franzoni who will verify all tests and issue the authorization to proceed to the accreditation.
- Outcome waiting time: 15/30 minutes for rapid antigen test results; ca. 6 hours for PCR test results
- Costs for own testing done before arrival at the event are carried by the single person or responsible group
 - o Cost for rapid antigen test: 25,00€ per unit
 - o Cost for PCR test: 75,00€ per unit
- ➤ Costs for on-site rapid antigen test, arranged by the Organiser and national health authorities, are carried by the Organising Committee
- In case of positive antigen test result:
 - Isolation at the venue/in the hotel
 - PCR Test will be conducted
 - Isolation until test result
 - In case of positive PCR test result further measures and tests will be coordinated by local health authorities

REPORTING OF SICKNESS DURING THE EVENT

- ➤ In case of feeling sick contact OC & FIS designated contact persons immediately
- Isolation at the venue / in the hotel
- > Test will be conducted
- Isolation until test result
- ➤ In case of a positive test result further measures and tests will be coordinated by FIS and local health authorities















AT THE VENUE/FINISH AREA

- Temperature check at all entrances
- Reduce time at the venue to a minimum
- Keep distance to others as much as possible
- Wear masks
- Respect ways/paths and signage at the venue
- > No meals available in the finish area except for designated OC Staff
- All areas will be delimited using fences to avoid contact between various groups, avoid unauthorised access and keep entries and exits separated

MEETINGS

- ➤ The different meetings are held in the respect of the Local Covid protocol with the appropriate distancing measures
- Wear face masks at all times
- Team Captains Meeting
 - Will be organized as a mixed meeting with a limited number of people
 - o Only one person per team will be allowed to access the meeting
 - o For Media it will be accessible only via livestreaming
 - Bib Draw will be held at Team Captains Meeting
- Press Conference
 - Will be held via livestreaming.
 Location: Event Hall at Casa della Cultura
 - Reduced contact to athletes
 - Respect general rules of behaviour















TEAMS & SUPPLYING PARTNERS

ACCOMMODATION

- Separated hotels for teams
- Check-in at allocated hotel will only be possible after you've picked up the accreditation at the Race Office
- Allocation/booking of accommodation for teams only via OC
- Avoid elevators
- Try to stay separated from other hotel guests
- Separated beds in shared rooms are highly recommended
- In case of common spaces, review the circulation flow and distancing policy
- > If possible, use separated access to hotel
- Usage of hotel gym, pools, saunas only if reserved exclusively for athletes
- No training in hotel hallways
- Respect the general rules of hygiene and follow hotel rules

Hotels will follow the National Health Regulations and try to adjust to the FIS official guidelines as well.

TRAINING

- No training possibilities before the event in Alta Badia
- ➤ Bamby slope will be available for GS and SL training on Saturday, December 19th, Sunday December 20th and Monday, December 21st
- No public Gym will be available for training

TRAVEL, TRANSPORT & PARKING

- Organize own transport/transfer from hotel to the venue and from the finish area to the gondola since this is considered the safest and fastest option by the medical experts.
- No transfer will be organized from OC from finish area to gondola; please use own team shuttle
- Parking at gondola station Piz La Villa will be available; access only with specific pass handed out when collecting accreditation
- Ferrata Piz La Villa will be reserved for OC staff, no access for athletes
- Separated access to the gondola for teams; enter the gondola only with athletes from same team















TRACK AND FINISH AREA

- Limited training times possible
- Track inspection divided by groups to avoid unnecessary contacts
- Start Tent
 - Only one athlete and 2 officials per team
 - Face mask to be worn for the officials at all time
 - Social distancing
- For technicians and Supplying Partners
 - remain distant from athletes
- Bibs will be handed out by one person and only outdoors
- Sanitary containers available in the finish area and at Top Station Piz La Villa

TEAM HOSPITALITY & MEALS

- > Team Hospitality at Club Moritzino will be available Sunday, December 20th and Monday, December 21st from 7 am to 1 pm
- Access to team hospitality at Moritzino only with specific pass handed out by
- Temperature check at all entrances
- Lunch and hot & cold drinks for athletes, team-staff and coaches will be provided through Self Service
- > Tables and sitting facilities for each team
- Non-qualified athletes shall have meals in the hotel
- No meals in the finish area
- Wearing of masks is mandatory in all areas except when sitting at the table for
- Reserved sanitary facilities for athletes available at the top station of Piz La Villa

PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

- The official prize giving ceremony will be held in the finish area immediately after the race (on Sunday and on Monday)
- Wear a mask at all times
- Avoid contact to other athletes
- Avoid handshaking
- Keep the designated distance
- Respect signage
- Respect the general rules of hygiene
- Trophies will be placed on the podium

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MEDIA

TRANSPORT

- If possible, Media should attend the event using their own transport
- Transport from the press centre to the finish area and vice versa will be organized by the LOC according to local health prevention guidelines
- Respect the general rules of hygiene on transportation means

ON SITE

- Masks must be worn in all indoor and outdoor accredited areas
- > All journalists should bring enough masks to last through the event
- Masks need to cover both nose and mouth
- Social distancing should be obeyed
- Journalist should limit their movements
- Media will not be able to have direct access to athletes, competition areas or team zones (Min. 2 meter distance from athletes)
- All interviews must be conducted in the finish area, respecting the social distancing policy
- All microphones should have a plastic cover over the foam that is replaced after each interview. The microphone should stay only with the athlete and the journalist should not speak into it as well
- Journalists should never, under any circumstance, ask an athlete to remove their mask
- Sanitary facilities for media are available at the LOC's headquarters
- For Media: separated accreditation for races in Val Gardena and Alta Badia

PHOTO ZONES

- Masks will need to be worn on and off course
- Maintain social distancing on and off course
- ➤ Photographers will not be able to enter the finish areas to take photos of the ceremonies. Instead, the podiums will be placed in such a way that photos of the ceremony are possible from the photo stands in the finish area















ZONES AND WAYS

Media Routes:

 The ways on the venue will change significantly and it is likely that longer ways have to be accepted since the various groups cannot mix on their way to certain zones.

Media Centre:

- Location: Casa della Cultura (Str. Colz 75, 39036 La Villa in Badia)
 Entry on floor -2
- Access: the access to the press centre will only be granted upon pre reservation; Temperature check upon arrival
- Workstations: Stations are available upon prior reservation and will be the same for each working day.
- Services: The services in the media centre will be reduced (including catering, printing, information desk) and journalists attending the events will need to prepare in a way that they are self-reliant
- Space: The media centre will be laid out in a way to ensure that social distancing regulations can be adhered to
- Meals: There will be an area in the Media Centre for meals but what will be offered will be significantly reduced from previous years. Meals will be provided only to participants with booked workstation in press centre. The Lunch-packets will be distributed on Sunday and Monday morning on each desk. There are specific areas where they can be consumed.
- Sanitary facilities on site
- Respect the general rules of hygiene
- After Race Press Conference will be held via livestreaming. Media will get a link to access the meeting.

Commentator cabins:

- Access: max. 2 people with negative Covid -19 test per cabin. Only 2 people from the same broadcaster
- Meals: Lunch packets available in assigned cabin
- Respect general rules of hygiene.
- Sanitary facilities are available at the LOC's headquarters

It is suggested to report the entry in South Tyrol to the local health authorities at the following link: https://siag.limequery.org/483785

- Citizens arriving from EU and SCHENGEN Area countries, the United Kingdom and Northern Ireland, Andorra and Monaco are permitted to enter South Tyrol / Italy.



FINISH AREA


















PRESS CENTRE


















ACCREDITATION AND RACE OFFICE


















PARKING PIZ LA VILLA


















PIZ LA VILLA: VALLEY STATION


















PIZ LA VILLA: TOP STATION










