GENERAL PRINCIPLES

- Determined by current national regulations in Bulgaria (Ministry of Health, Ministry of Youth and Sports and Regional Health Inspectorate (RHI)).
- Protocols take into consideration recommendations made by the International Ski Federation (FIS).
- Testing protocols established for all accredited individuals for the duration of the event.
- Cost of test to be paid by the person requesting the test.

"RACE" BUBBLE TESTING PROTOCOL

Ski teams + Ski team staff + FIS staff

To get accredited, you need to:

1. Present the results:

To possess a negative PCR test conducted within 72 hours of arrival at the venue

The results must appear in one's FIS PASSPORT 12 hours before the accreditation pick up at Race office - Hotel Strazhite.

2. Fill out the FIS questionnaire.

"ORGANIZER" BUBBLE TESTING PROTOCOL

OC members, Course staff, Judges, Service providers, Medical team and Mountain rescuers

"MEDIA AND PARTNERS" BUBBLE TESTING PROTOCOL

Press center staff, Media, Photographers, Timing & Data, Radio center, TV crew INFRONT

To possess a negative PCR test conducted within 72 hours of arrival at the venue
The results must appear in one's FIS PASSPORT 12 hours before the accreditation pick up at Accreditation desk in Media's Hotel.
2. Fill out the FIS questionnaire.

PROTOCOLS TO FOLLOW FOR: CASES WITH SYMPTOMS / POSITIVE CASES/ CONTACT CASES

Suspicion:

**Someone showing symptoms:
Inform the Covid-19 Coordinator**

1. Immediately isolate /quarantine the person in the room designated for this purpose: conduct a medical consult with Covid-19 Coordinator D-r Gueorgui Maximov +359 886 66 12 48
2. If the symptoms are not suspicious >> conduct a quick antigen test. If the test is positive, confirmation with PCR
3. If the symptoms are suspicious >> conduct a PCR test
4. If the PCR test is negative >> the returning to the event is possible after a medical consult and approval by the Covid-19 Coordinator.

**Positive PCR but individual
is asymptomatic**

1. Immediate quarantine for 14 days.
2. Later on the returning to the event is possible after a medical consult and approval by the Covid-19 Coordinator.

Contact cases:

**Identified by
COVID-19 Coordinator**

1. Evaluation of the situation by the Covid-19 Coordinator.
2. If the evaluation by the Covid-19 Coordinator shows real contact risk >> Immediately isolate /quarantine the person in the room designated for this.

Contact cases: Identified by COVID-19 Coordinator

3. Conduct PCR test:
 - If negative test result: 10 days quarantine. Later on the returning to the event is possible after a medical consult and approval by the Covid-19 Coordinator
 - Positive test result: quarantine for 14 days
4. Covid-19 Coordinator assess the contact cases and the contact risk.
