COVID-19 team information for tests and test protocols Update from 21st December 2020

With this document we would like to inform all teams again about COVID-19 tests and COVID-19 test results for the AUDI FIS Ski World Cup taking place at 12th January 2021.

- Every team member officially named by the respective national ski association via the FIS online system is obliged to present a negative **PCR test not older than 72 hours** (max. 72h between taking the sample/swab and collecting accreditation).
- The presentation of a positive COVID-19 antibody test will not be accepted. People who showed a positive PCR test in the past 3 months need to upload a new PCR test (not older than 72h) to the FIS Passport. If the test result is positive and the CT value >30, accreditation is possible. People with a first time positive PCR test within the last 2 weeks prior to arrival are not allowed to participate in the event!
- **Tests conducted outside Austria:** The PCR test presented needs to be recognised by the health authority of the respective country! After testing, the following information about the test laboratory needs to be provided sending an email to <u>wolfgang.schobersberger@tirol-kliniken.at</u>:

It is not necessary to send the information about the laboratory in advance for approval!

- **Tests conducted in Austria:** The PCR test presented needs to be authorised by the Austrian health authority! Therefore, we would like to name the following laboratories:
 - Novogenia Lab in Salzburg/Eugendorf: Tests can be ordered online via the following link: <u>https://shop.novogenia.com/kategorie/novo-immune/</u>. With the voucher "ski2020" you receive a 20% discount. Please consider delivery times when ordering (currently delivery within Austria takes up to 3 days!).
 - COVID19 Test Center Flachau: PCR tests taken prior to arrival are preferred. In case of any problems with foreign PCR tests, the COVID19 test center in Flachau is available. In the COVID19 test center in Flachau, PCR tests can be carried out during the entire Ski World Cup (daily during the day and in the evening appointment requested).

- For all PCR tests it is necessary to indicate the time when taking the sample.
- In case of unclear PCR test results, the LOC reserves the right to ask you to take a new test at the Test Center Flachau.
- Countries with current travel restrictions for entry into Austria can find information on the website of the Austrian Foreign Ministry at https://www.bmeia.gv.at/ or at the Austrian embassy in your country.
- The COVID-19 test protocol of every single team member needs to be uploaded to the FIS Passport system at least 12 hours prior to the collection of the accreditation.

- <u>For the Single Point of Contact (SPOC) dial +43 6457 3073-20</u> it can be reached 24 hours a day between Sunday and Tuesday. If anyone in the team shows COVID-19 symptoms, please contact the SPOC immediately.
- **COVID-19 suspect case management:** If there is a COVID-19 suspect case, please contact the SPOC. There will be a team from the Austrian Red Cross based at Flachau organising further procedures including isolation and contacting the authorities (the district commission of St. Johann im Pongau). Appropriate rooms will be available if an isolation is necessary. In case of a positive test result, the authorities decide on possible quarantine of further people in the surroundings (e.g. team members).
- Furthermore, the medical confirmation below (according to Appendix 1), which is required by the authorities in Austria, must be completed and signed by each team at the accreditation.
- Daily health check: Prior to every training session and competition, every team member must fill in the daily health check and provide it to the LOC. <u>Therefore, please scan the QR</u> <u>code of your accreditation every morning and fill in the respective questionnaire online.</u> This is mandatory for all team members!
