Every competitor, coaches and staff has to present a negative COVID-19 test result (PCR or Antigen) , which must not be older than 48 hours before the first race start. The negative test result must be presented when collecting the accreditation or sent by email to booking@paganella.net



COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR FIS EVENT

INTRODUCTION

- This Protocol applies to FIS competitions including FIS, NC, NJR, UNI, CIT, CITWC, MAS, OPA, JUN, CHI competitions in Italy for FIS disciplines (except WC events that are ruled by the FIS specific protocol).
- It supplements and does not replace the national and regional regulations for:
 - a. use of lifts or other means of transport.
 - b. access to the competition venues.
 - c. use of hotel or restaurant services.
 - d. social distancing.
 - e. collective hygiene standards and use of personal protective equipment.

COMPETITION COURSE (Race track and adjacent areas, start and arrival area)

- Must have a delimited access with an individual entrance to the track and one or more dedicated and marked exit routes.
- Only accredited competitors, technicians, judges, and other competition officials, rescue and technical support staff are allowed.
- No spectators are allowed.
- The presence of possible spectators outside it is ruled by the regional and national regulations.

ACCESS TO THE COMPETITION COURSE

- It is mandatory to wear the race bib.
- The staff of the organizing committee must take the body temperature at the entrance: if the temperature is $> 37.5^{\circ}$ → 2nd measurement after 5 minutes

if still $> 37.5^{\circ}$ → access forbidden

PUBLIC PICK/PUBLIC DRAW

- To pick up the bib it is mandatory to submit the form (Annex 1).
- For non-disposable bibs, sanitation is necessary after each use.
- Bibs must be delivered to the team leader:
 - no contact with the athletes by other personnel;
 - if necessary, put the bibs on a bib holder where athletes can pick up them.
- No public draw ceremony.

START AREA

- A departure area large enough to guarantee the required distance must be defined.
- Everyone allowed in the area must wear the mask.
- Athletes can only remove the mask within the starting area 5 minutes before their starting time.
- only one accompanying person per competitor is allowed.
- Make sure that the way out for the guests does not interfere with the competitors waiting to start.
- In order to avoid gathering, please respect the starting time of the competitors.

TEAM HOSPITALITY (IF ALLOWED)



- Review the space to respect the appropriate distances.
- Reduce the number of volunteers in this area to the minimum necessary.
- It is forbidden to organise buffets.
- Provide food in single portions.
- Provide sufficient quantity of water in single bottles.
- Provide drinks in single bottles.
- Limit interaction/connection between volunteers and team members.
- Clean and sanitise regularly and exchange air when teams are not present.
- Reduce the number of volunteers in the area where the distance is limited.

ARRIVAL AREA

- Everyone allowed in the area must wear the mask. Athletes must wear the mask if they stay longer than necessary.
- it is forbidden to organise buffets.
- Provide sufficient quantity of drink in single bottles.
- No “change tent” on arrival.
- The athletes must leave the common area as soon as possible.
- Please make sure that the transport of the athlete’s equipment from the start area to the arrival area is provided only by the team personnel.
- Have the athletes put bibs and chips in plastic containers at the end of the race.

AWARD CEREMONIES

- They are allowed outdoor and in the arrival area.
- Respect social distancing.
- No public award ceremony

JURY MEETINGS

- One club/regional committee representative is allowed to attend the jury meeting. If spaces are not appropriate these meetings must be held online.

FURTHER PROVISIONS

- Everyone involved in the organisation must wear personal protective equipment (approved masks).
- Athletes, Technicians and staff must wear personal protective equipment (approved masks)
