- Determined by current national regulations in Slovenia (Health Ministry, Sports Ministry, SZS, and National Institute of Public Health (NIJZ)).
- Protocols developed with and verified by NIJZ (Regional Unit Maribor).
- Protocols take into consideration recommendations made by the International Ski Federation (FIS).
- ❖ Testing protocols established for all accredited individuals for the duration of the event.
- Cost of test to be paid by the person requesting the test.

"RACE" BUBBLE TESTING PROTOCOL

Ski teams + Ski team staff + FIS staff

To get accredited, you need to:

1. Present the results:

- ❖ For a nasal RT-PCR test >0 conducted within 72 hours of arrival at the venue
- ❖ Or for an "Abott or Roche" serology test >0 less than 8 weeks old
- ❖ In addition to negative test conducted within 72 hours of arrival, every person need to make antigen test at Covid Test center in Kranjska Gora. Test needs to be made before check in to hotel.

The results must appear in one's FIS PASSPORT 12 hours before the accreditation retrieval area opens for the race sanitary bubble so that the COVID-19 medical coordinator can review and approve them.

2. Fill out the FIS questionnaire.

During the races you can get tested:

Quick results RT-PCR or antigen tests by appointment (CONTACT OC COVID-19 CENTER)

On December 30th, the organizer will send to all Team Captains an email with a link that will provide access to a shared online schedule to make an appointment..

Contact organizing committee as soon as possible to make an appointment before the races.

After the races:

Contact the Maribor COVID-19 unit medical coordinator if any known symptoms appear.

The Organizing Committee recommends that you:

- Download the "#OstaniZdrav" (all against covid) application
- Get a flu shot
- Fill out the FIS questionnaire before each test

"ORGANIZER" BUBBLE TESTING PROTOCOL

Media team + Timing team + Journalists + Photographers + Infront TV team

To get accredited, you need to:

- 1. Present the results for a nasal RT-PCR test >0 conducted within 72 hours of arrival at the venue.
- 2. Fill out the FIS quesitonnaire.
- 3. In addition to negative test conducted within 72 hours of arrival, every person needs to make antigen test at Covid Test center in Kranjska Gora at arrival.

During the races you can get tested:

Quick results RT-PCR or antigen tests by appointment

Contact organizing committee as soon as possible to make an appointment before the races.

After the races:

Contact the Maribor COVID-19 medical coordinator if any known symptoms appear.

- Get a flu shot
- Fill out the FIS questionnaire before each test

PROTOCOLS TO FOLLOW FOR:

CASES WITH SYMPTOMS / POSITIVE CASES/ CONTACT CASES

Suspected case:

Someone showing typical symptoms:

Inform the medical coordinator

- 1. Immediately isolate /quarantine the person in the room designated for this purpose: conduct an antigen or a RT-PCR test and a remote medical consult.
- 2. If the antigen test is positive **O** conduct a second RT-PCR test.
- 3. If the RT-PCR test is negative returning to the event is possible after a remote medical consult.
- 4. If the RT-PCR test is positive
 → additional min. 10-day quarantine if tested person has no fiver for the last 2 days. Returning to the event is possible after a remote medical consult and approval from the medical center doctor.

Positive PCR or antigen test, but individual is asymptomatic

Immediate quarantine for min. 10 days if tested person has no fiver for the last 2 days. Returning to the event is possible after approval from the medical center doctor.

Contact cases: Identified by NIJZ and/or COVID-19 unit

- 1. Immediately isolate /quarantine the person for min. 10-day quarantine if tested person has no fiver for the last 2 days..
- 2. If no symptoms **②** conduct an RT-PCR test at T + 7 days:
 - Negative test result: return to the event
 - Positive test result: quarantine for 7 more days
- 3. If showing symptoms conduct an antigen or RT-PCR test
 - If antigen test positive conduct a second RT-PCR test
 - If results of second test are negative or return to the event
 - If results of second test are positive additional min. 10-day quarantine if tested person has no fiver for the last 2 days. Returning to the event is possible after a remote medical consult and approval from the medical center doctor.

PREVIOUSLY INFECTED PERSON POLICY

Positive test
between 14 to 90 days
prior arrival

- 1. Person who was tested positive between 14 to 90 days prior arrival to Kranjska Gora is treated like exception if the person gets in touch with positive person. That means there will be no quarantine from Slovenian National Health institute (NIJZ).
- 2. Conditions to enter Slovenian border are available at https://www.gov.si/en/topics/coronavirus-disease-covid-19/border-crossing/ under Exceptions without quarantine and negative PCR test

NEXT EVENT COVID-19 TESTING

LOC will provide PCR and Antigen test at COVID CENTRE at Kranjska Gora.

Price for PCR test is 98,00 € and for ANTIGEN test is 25,00 €.
