| 1  | Prevention                                  | <ul> <li>Health takes the highest priority; a high level of solidarity and individual responsibility is required.</li> <li>Persons with COVID-19 symptoms must not attend the event.</li> <li>If a case of COVID-19 is diagnosed after an event (after a max. of 14 days), the LOC must be informed of this immediately thrue the COVID-19 Hotline.</li> <li>All of the information must be entered truthfully.</li> </ul>  |
| 2  | Information<br>and reporting<br>obligations | For teams prior to arrival:  ➤ Mandatory registration in the FIS COVID-19 database – FIS Passport.  ➤ The following information must be uploaded to the FIS C-19 database by 12 noon on the day on which accreditations are to be collected:  - Negative Covid-19 PCR test result including the testing date and the national laboratory certificate  - "FIS Whereabouts"  - "FIS Health Questionnaires"  ➤ At arrival to Kranjska Gora before check-in to hotel and before accreditation pickup local ANTIGEN COVID-19 test need to be made at COVID-19 test center in Kransjka Gora.  ➤ Person without local antigen COVID-19 test will not be provided with accreditation. This means that they will not be able to gain access to the event grounds and must self-isolate before filling out the documents. |
| 3  | Arrival                                     | <ul> <li>▶ The LOC shall inform the teams about the current entry regulations.</li> <li>▶ The team must remain separate from external parties during the journey to the event.</li> <li>▶ During the journey, the team must avoid taking long breaks, particularly at highly frequented places such and must adhere to the general rules of conduct.</li> </ul>   |
| 4  | Accreditation                               | <ul> <li>▶ The accreditations must be picked up altogether by the team manager (1 person) of each team.</li> <li>▶ The accreditation serves as part of our contact tracing system and must be worn on your person at all times.</li> <li>▶ The accreditation must in no circumstances be given to third parties.</li> </ul>   |
| 5  | Mask obligation                             | <ul> <li>Everyone must wear a face mask in all areas and accreditation zones on the event grounds.</li> <li>Protective masks do not have to be worn in the following exceptional circumstances:         <ul> <li>By athletes immediately before, during and after the competition</li> <li>During meal times after individuals have sat down at their tables</li> </ul> </li> <li>The TCM shall provide information about the rules surrounding the wearing of masks on the leaderboard and when announcing results.</li> <li>The participants shall be responsible for sourcing masks themselves.</li> </ul>   |
| 6  | Separation of groups and teams              | <ul> <li>People from different colour groups must not mix with one another.</li> <li>People from the "Red" colour group must not mix with one another for periods of more than 15 minutes.</li> <li>Teams must not mix with other teams within Team Hospitality.</li> </ul>   |
| 7  | Covid-19<br>testing                         | <ul> <li>Everyone must present a negative Covid-19 test that was carried out no more than 72 hours before arrival and make local ANTIGEN COVID-19 test before check-in to hotel and accreditation pickup.</li> <li>The test must be officially recognised and certified in the country in which it was carried out.</li> <li>The task force can have people who have symptoms take a COVID-19 quick test.</li> <li>The task force may at any time arrange for quick tests to be carried out unannounced.</li> <li>In the event of a positive result being returned by the COVID-19 quick test, a COVID-19 PCR test must also be carried out to validate the quick-test result.</li> <li>The costs for additional tests must be paid on the spot by the person being tested.</li> </ul>                          |
| 8  | What to do if<br>you experience<br>symptoms | <ol> <li>Should you develop symptoms, you must inform the team manager immediately. The affected person must enter self-isolation immediately.</li> <li>The team manager shall inform the COVID-19 Officer of the LOC immediately via the COVID-19 Hotline.</li> <li>The COVID-19 Officer shall inform the task force.</li> <li>The task force shall consult the national authorities and make a decision on the next steps to take.</li> <li>Any information provided to third parties (the media, etc.) must be approved by the task force.</li> </ol>  |
| 9  | Leisure time                                | <ul> <li>Leisure activities are to be avoided, where possible.</li> <li>Every person shall be responsible for their own actions and activities during their leisure time.</li> </ul>  |
| 10 | Training and implementation                 | <ul> <li>The team manager shall be responsible for providing team members with internal training.</li> <li>The team manager undertakes to hand out the COVID-19 GUIDELINES to all team members at the latest on the evening before the first official team event (training or competition) and to inform the team about the protection regulations.</li> </ul>  |
