Due to COVID-19 restrictions

We would like to inform you about our FIS races from 11.01. – 12.01.2021 which will take place in Gaal. Through the strict regulations from our government for preventing COVID 19 infections, negative COVID-19 testresults (PCR or Rapid Antigen) for every participant and



coaches are required prior the event. Everybody has to present a negative COVID-19 testresult (PCR or Antigen), which must not be older than 72 hours before the first start of the competition, otherwise its it not allowed to use the gondola and to join the race area.

Covid test confirmation can be submitted at the chair lift ground station on the 1st race day to the responsible COVID-19 manager.

Bibs will be available at the chair lift ground station in the morning
