Important Information about Covid-19!

Dear athletes, trainers, staff usw..

We would like to inform you about our Europa Cup event which will take place from Wednesday 16th to Thursday 17th of December in Hippach/Zillertal.

The official arrival date is Tuesday, December 15th.

Through the strict regulations from the Austrian government for preventing COVID-19 infections, every competitior, coaches and staff has to present a negative COVID-19 testresult (PCR or Antigen) prior the event.

Everbody who wants to get an accreditation for the event has to present a negative COVID – 19 testresult (PCR or Antigen), which must not be older than 72 hours before the first race start. First race start is on Wednesday, 16th of December at 10am.

The negative test result must be presented when collecting the accreditation. (accreditation is available on Tuesday 15th of December from 1pm to 6pm at Europhahaus Mayrhofen)

Important:

No accreditation available without negative test result.

If positive corona cases with an accompanying quarantine are necessary, the organizer will not be held liable for the accommodation costs.

Should this occur, the respective national association is independently responsible for the costs.

COVID – Registration & Health Questionnaire!

Every athlete, coach and staff needs tot do the registration & health questionnaire every race day before heading up to the race venue with link.

- The races will be closed to the spectators just participating athletes and responsible team coaches are allowed to stay at event facilities.
- Gondola = all Persons must wear a FFP2 Mask
- Everyone which is allowed in the start/finish area must wear a mask.

Important information for Team Captains

EC-GS Hippach 16.-17.12.2020

Dear team captains. Please read through the following rules very carefully. These regulations are established by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Health, Austrian Ski Federation and the LOC in cooperation with FIS. It is your responsibility to inform your entire team and make sure all members follow these rules without exceptions.

1. What is important:

- Take personal responsibility very serious
- hygiene measures at all times (regular hand washing, regular disinfection)
- maintain a minimum distance of 1 meter in all areas (social distancing)
- · wear mouth and nose protection at all times





- on the entire event site, except during meal, during the practice of sport and in the start area right before the start
- inside all buildings
- for all transports in buses, shuttles, gondolas, chair lifts
- in the common areas of your accommodation

2. COVID-19 tests:

- Everbody (athletes, coaches and staff) who wants to get an accreditation for the event needs to present a negative COVID-19 test result (PCR or Rapid Antigen Test), which must not be older than 72 hours before the first race start. The negative test result must be presented when collecting the accreditations.
- Accreditation for persons with a previously diagnosed COVID-19 infection
 - present the PCR COVID-19 positive test result made between 2 weeks and 3 months before the arrival
 - free of COVID-19 symptoms for a minimum of 3 days before arrival

3. Transportation rules for cars/team busses:

- · max two people can be carried in each row of seats
- mouth nose protection mandatory

4. Rules for Hotel/Accomodation:

- professional athletes and coaches are allowed to stay in hotels, closed for the public
- mouth nose protection everywhere, except at the table while meals

5. Transportation rules for gondola/chairlift:

- checkpoint bottom station for the correct questionnaire by the COVID-19 Manager
- FFP2 masks mandatory for gondola, possibility to get one at the bottom station
- · mouth nose protection for chairlift
- · half capacity at all times
- · staggered, team by team

6. Avoid crowds: inspection, toilets, gondola, chairlift

• spend your free time only with members of your team in small groups

7. COVID-19 Communication

- in case of COVID-19 symptoms immediately inform the COVID-19 Manager Jürgen Kriechbaum

- COVID-19 Manager activates the necessary COVID-19 measures
- all communication regarding COVID-19 must be coordinated with LOC and FIS

has do be filled out and sent online mandatory every morning before showing up at the bottom station of the gondola (will be controlled)

9. Team Captains Meeting (TCM)

Only one team captain per nation is allowed to attend the team captains meeting.
