Due to COVID-19 restrictions

We would like to inform you about our FIS races from 28.01. – 29.01.2021 which will take place in Gaal. Through the strict regulations from our government for preventing COVID 19 infections, negative COVID-19 testresults (PCR or Rapid Antigen) for every participant and coaches are required prior the event. Everybody has to present a negative COVID-19 testresult (PCR or Antigen), which must not be older than 72 hours before the first start of the competition, otherwise its it not allowed to use the gondola and to join the race area.

Covid test confirmation can be submitted at the chair lift ground station to the responsible COVID-19 manager.

Bibs will be available at the chair lift ground station in the morning

The races will be closed to the spectators - just participate athletes and responsible team coaches allowed to stay at event facilities

No prize giving ceremony

Athletes can only remove the mask within the starting area
