## Accommodation

Because of COVID-19 situation please note that accommodation for all participating FIS member federations and all other participants will be arranged and coordinated ONLY by the OC Office. Contact OC: [barbora.tomesova@vysocina-arena.cz](mailto:barbora.tomesova@vysocina-arena.cz)

If any accommodation is not used in full as requested – or partly – without submission of notice by the official deadline, the entering federation will be held liable for the costs. The entire period for which the hotel is contracted shall be paid for. Earlier departure or changes made without notification will not be considered.

## Accreditation

### Accreditation of the teams

The registration and accreditation of the teams will take place in the Nové Město Sports Hall at the address Sportovní č. p. 1583, Nové Město na Moravě. All teams need to present themselves at the accreditation and collect local OC accreditation cards that will supplement the FIS Season accreditation. Each team shall send only one representative to collect cards for the whole team. A negative PCR COVID-19 test not older than 72-hours to the date of the accreditation is necessary.

### Opening hours:

Thursday 18 February 08.00 – 20.00

Friday 19 February 08.00 – 18.00

Saturday 20 February 08.00 – 13.00

Sunday 21 February 08.00 – 13.00

The accreditation cards are used for identification of persons and for granting access into the respected competition zones. The accreditations are non-transferable and the holders shall always present them to persons assigned by the OC – the security service staff members wearing uniforms - whenever passing from one accreditation zone into another. The security control start from Thursday 18 February from 8:00.

From Thursday February 18 entrance to the Venue will be only possible with a valid LOC accreditation.

## Transport

### Transport and Parking

It is recommended that members of Teams/SRS/FIS should travel to Nové Město na Moravě in their own vehicles for the safest journey.

All teams will receive an assigned set of parking permissions for their own vehicles that must be placed inside the windshield. The parking permissions allow for free passage into the Vysocina Arena and parking in the parking place P2 (opposite the team area).

The transportation office arranges daily requests of the teams about transportation (organized by the OC) from the hotels into the Vysocina Arena and back. There will be the official transportation form available in the office where teams shall write their exact requests



on transportation (times, amount of persons, pick-up and drop-off points).

Requests for transportation must be submitted in the transportation sub-office no later than 18.00 on the day preceding the day of the requested transportation.

Transport from/to Prague airport before/after the competition should be booked well in advance.

## Reimbursement

## Medical Service & Health protection plan

### Covid-19 Testing before arrival

Covid-19 tests should be performed before arrival to Nové Město na Moravě / Czech Republic, in accordance with FIS Covid Protocol, shown in FIS Covid-19 Passport. An approved PCR-test at the latest 72 hours before your arrival (i.e. time of the accreditation).

### \* Arriving in the Czech Republic

\* When arriving from countries in the dark red & red category, it is mandatory to complete an arrival form and submit a PCR test result before entering the Czech Republic. PCR tests shall be at most 72 hours old. It will then be obligatory to take a second PCR test in the Czech Republic, no sooner than 5 days after arrival. Until the second negative test is submitted, self-isolation is required.

Travellers arriving to the Czech Republic from countries in the orange category must complete an arrival form before returning and also submit the result of PCR test (no more than 72 hours old).

## **Obligatory PCR Team testing at the Nové Město Sports Hall on 18 & 19 February**

The testing facility is indoor with an outdoor waiting area.

Following conditions set by the Department of Epidemiology and Public Health by the MoH (Ministry of Health) for organizing the World Cup, PCR testing of all teams (athletes, service, and officials) is requested on Thursday 18 February or Friday 19 February. Czech Lab by the Central Military Hospital in Prague will perform the testing. Results by 7:00 next morning, i.e. Friday 19 February & Saturday 20 February.

Testing windows for individual teams will be sent to teams after final name entries have been confirmed.

The LOC NMNM COVID-19 doctor will contact possible positives and advise consecutive steps.

## **WCH Oberstdorf PCR Testing on 20 February**

For all athletes and team members leaving to the WCH in Oberstdorf FIS is organizing a PCR Testing possibility by a German laboratory Synlab MVZ Weiden in order to have a PCR Test to enter Germany and also the World Championships venue (attention: you need to be at the venue within 48h after the test).

The testing will take place on Saturday 20 February in the evening hour at the Nové Město Sports Hall. See for address above. Exact schedule will be announced at a later time.

## **Protective facemasks**

All organizers, volunteers and members of security service in force will be PCR tested and required to wear face masks of KN95 standard, both indoors and outdoors.

## **Protective measures at accommodation**

All of the hotels are accustomed and have adapted their routines according to Covid-19 regulations for hotel residences.

In preparation that someone may become sick at the hotel, it is recommended in advance to book an extra room (own expense), all hotels will have free rooms for quarantine.

If someone becomes sick and isolation is required, the organizer will support them to find an extra room for the time duration that it is required. The team/company is responsible for these extra costs.



The hotels are following the FIS prevention guidelines for accommodation and meals such as:

- Dining rooms and buffets separated as much as possible
- Separated floors and room sections as much as possible
- Slot times for meals if necessary

## **Protective measures in the venue of competition**

Zones, checkpoints and flows are clearly marked in order to reduce risks for the spread of the Corona virus. Follow the official security service instructions about which flow you must follow! Refer to map.

### ***Changing rooms***

It is recommended for safety reasons to change and shower at the hotel. There is a limited amount of changing rooms indoors (containers) available in the Team Area.

Toilets are separated between the different groups and are often cleaned by separate personnel.

### ***First Aid Clinic for athletes and teams***

First Aid Clinic for athletes and teams is located inside the team area (will be signposted). Only emergency service and first-aid treatment of injuries will be provided by event doctors!

### ***Sanitary stations and waste bins***

Frequent numbers of sanitary stations and bins for used face masks will be placed all over the venue of competition.

### ***Public, audience***

The whole venue will be fenced and closed for spectators.

### ***Public, audience***

Isolation room will be provided by OC in the venue for suddenly unwell cases during competition and official training.

## **112- Emergencies**

Call 112, only in case of emergencies, such as urgent medical conditions, active crimes or fires. Declare arena address or the address of your respected hotels: Vysočina Arena, Vlachovická 1200, Nové Město na Moravě 592 31.

## **Testing protocol by LOC or host country**

All members of the red group (teams, officials, SRS, etc.) must have a negative Covid-19 PCR test to be accredited. The test must not be older than 72 hours and must be uploaded to the FIS Passport Tool.

## **Regulations of radio equipment/Radio Frequencies**

All teams are allowed to use either free frequencies included in the list of free frequencies or special reserved pay frequencies ordered according to the instructions issued by the organizer with the Czech Telecommunication Agency.

## **Regulations of Visa**

Citizens of the following FIS member countries need the entry visa when travelling to the Czech Republic: ARM, BLR, CHN, GEO, KAZ, KGZ, MNG, RUS, TUR, UZB.



## **Special permissions for truck driving (Sunday and night, other days with special regulations)**

Vehicles with weight over 7.5 tonnes, and also vehicles over 3.5 tonnes with an attached trailer are prohibited to drive on Czech major roads and highways on Sundays from 13:00 – 22:00.

The LOC of Nové Město is ready to arrange for special driving permissions for teams who wish to leave NMNM on Sunday 21 February in the afternoon hours straight after the competition. Such teams need to submit a copy of truck technical certificate and respective wax truck form no later than 10 February 2021 to the email [jakes@vysocina-arena.cz](mailto:jakes@vysocina-arena.cz).
