## Accommodation

- Booking according to the FIS Rules via FIS Online registration system
- The OC offers the following accommodation (full board included): CHF 125.00 (per person per night)
- Price for additional accommodation outside of the quota: on request

## Accreditation

All teams and staff have to use the FIS online registration system. On site one person of each team will hand over in the race office the signed RED ANNEX (Guidelines & Rules of Conduct) of every team member. In return the person receives the accreditations for each team member. They have to be carried on person all the time. Accreditation will only be possible to pick-up after the negative Covid-19 test (not older than 72 hours) of each team member is uploaded on the new FIS Passport system. The tests have to be uploaded 12 hours before accreditation starts on Wednesday, 30th of December, 14:00. The accreditation office is located in the race office. Only 1 person per team is allowed to pick up the accreditations for the whole team.

## Team Catering

Due to Covid-19 restrictions and preventions, all athletes and team members will eat all meals in the hotels. Outdoors at the venue there will be from 01.-03. January a container with a food counter where the athletes and teams can get a lunch bag with prepacked warm food as well as snacks and beverages (water).

## Transport

If you need a shuttle transfer please contact us on +41 81 861 88 40. Please be aware that due to COVID-19 it is mandatory to wear a mask in the waiting zone, airports, railway stations in public transport as well as in the OC-organised airport shuttles!

## Travelling to Switzerland

### Entering Switzerland through Italy

All teams should travel via Zurich to Val Müstair. Teams arriving in Zurich have to make a PCR test at Balgrist University Hospital in Zurich. After this, they travel to Val Müstair. The teams will only be accredited in Tschiers if they arrive already tested.

If though you travel via Italy into Switzerland without valid PCR-Test, you have to travel via Brenner-Pass and give us notice **until Wednesday 23. December**. Entering Italy is only possible if you commit to a Drive-In-Test in Bozen. After your answers, Bozen will coordinate the tests.

### Quarantine

The Swiss Federal Council resolved measures to curb the further spread of the coronavirus. Given the growing number of new infections it will be compulsory to wear a mask in all publicly accessible indoor spaces and at all public transport access points across Switzerland;



this includes, for example, restaurants, shops and theatres and railway stations, airports, bus and tram stops. Already since 6 July 2020 a mask-wearing requirement has applied to all public transport. More information about the actual situation in Switzerland is available on

## 5-day exception for Quarantine

Finally, persons who are entering Switzerland for up to 5 days for professional reasons and who cannot be postponed, are excluded. In justified cases, the competent cantonal authority may grant further exceptions from the obligation to quarantine or grant facilities. If an exemption is granted, then it must be ensured that those entering without quarantine are not infected, do not infect anyone. The cantons must make appropriate specifications within the scope of the exemption. It goes without saying that the above-mentioned persons cannot be exempted from the obligation of quarantine if they show symptoms of a disease with Covid-19 (paragraph 4). This can only be deviated from if the symptoms are due to another cause. The quarantine cannot be waived if, after the return journey to Switzerland a test is made, which turns out negative; because the person could be infected nevertheless, and only develop a positive result in the following days.

## VISA for third countries

For third countries a visa is required for entry. Even though no visas are issued at the moment due to the Covid situation, there is a solution for professionals and professional athletes. Please contact the Swiss embassy in your country. To obtain a visa, the Swiss representation in the respective country must be contacted. They are authorized to issue a permit. If you receive a negative decision against all expectations, please contact us with your request, so we can help you.

## Reimbursement

Accommodation costs: Teams will pay directly at the Race Office / Accreditation Office.

Reimbursement: All payments will be done by bank transfer at the end of the tour

Athletes from Switzerland and Liechtenstein are excluded from the income tax. By all other nation we have to subtract the income tax from the by bank transferred prize money. The income tax is the following:

- Income tax for prize money until CHF 200.- 12.8 %
- Income tax for prize money from CHF 201 to 1'000.- 14.4 %
- Income tax for prize money from CHF 1'001 to 3'000.- 17.0 %
- Income tax for prize money higher than CHF 3'001.- 19.0 %

The prize money payments will be done by bank transfer. Please make sure you send the completed prize money form within a few days after the event to the OC!



## Waxing facilities

Wax cabins: available from Wednesday, 30th of December 2020.

Waxing trucks: teams arriving with trucks have to inform the OC before 15th of December 2020

The keys to the cabins are available at the Race Office. The deposit is 50.00 € or CHF per team. Keys return at the Race Office on the day of departure.

## Medical Service & Health protection plan

### Testing protocol and health protection plan

All teams or all members of the red group have to arrive with a negative PCR test, which must be uploaded to the FIS-C-19 database 12 hours in advance. If it is not possible for a team to present this test, an appointment can be set until 23.12.2020 (Email to [teampraxis@csvm.ch](mailto:teampraxis@csvm.ch)) in order to do a PCR-test on 29.12.2020 until 16.30. Tests have to be paid on site (CHF 220, cash or creditcard).

### Daily Questionnaire

If in the daily health questionnaire one answer is answered with "yes" (sudden symptoms), you can do a test at the Center da Sanda Val Müstair. In the event of a negative test, this person may, with the confirmation of the test, re-enter the event site. If the test result is positive, a PCR test must be performed and this person must go to a quarantine according to BAG (Federal office of public health - FOPH). The quarantine can be cleared by the responsible authority.

### Commuting from Italy to Val Müstair

There is an agreement with Italy that all teams staying in hotels in Italy can move to the venue Val Müstair and back to Italy during the complete time of the event. There is no additional test result needed.

### Onward Journey to Toblach

All event participants who are going to the next stage (including media) have to do an antigen-test in Val Müstair. Starting on Sunday 3rd January 9 am. LOC Val Müstair and the FIS are developing a schedule that shows who is tested and at what time.

## Regulations of radio equipment/Radio Frequencies

Since 2013 the legislator has restricted the usable frequency range for certain wireless devices multiple times and exempted from the license-obligation. This increases the risk of interference between wireless devices at large events. In order to guarantee the same level of production reliability in the future and enable everyone to enjoy interference-free operation, SRF will coordinate the frequencies on behalf of the event organiser Tour de Ski Val Müstair.

For the above-mentioned reasons, all users must register their wireless devices in advance. Wireless devices may not be used if they have not been registered.

## Special permissions for truck driving (Sunday and night, other days with special regulations)



- Attention: In case of heavy snowfall the Ofenpass might be closed, please inform you before you drive. Therefore and because of customs we strictly advise you to get in and get out of Val Müstair through the Border in Müstair-Taufers. If you drive on Sunday or at night with your trucks you need a permission in Switzerland, Tirol and as well in South Tirol. We please ask the trucks to stay until Monday or making sure that you get all the permissions.
